Jesus' message contrasts Religion's message in two main areas... Jesus *exposes as vain* what Religion *espouses*: **A.** Sinful Man can't get to heaven on personal merit. Religion offers no guarantee of overcoming the effects of sin. **B.** Jesus *provides* what Religion *vainly promises*:
