"Radical Claim Divinely Substantiated"

INTRO: *Jesus claimed many radical things. His second radical claim at the Feast of Tabernacles coincided with the Light ceremony. But not all accept Jesus' claims. To these skeptics, Jesus provided heavenly substantiation.*

I. Jesus made radical _____ that confirmed His _____ (8:12). *His claim to be **The Light of the World** was the second "I AM" statement in John's Gospel (Cf. 6:35) and was made more dramatic by its timing.*

II. Skeptics reject Jesus' radical _____ even though they are substantiated by the _____ (8:13-29). *Four times Jesus used the phrase, **who sent Me**. Three times He expanded the phrase to describe how the One (He/ Father) who sent Him corroborated Jesus' claim.*

III. Confidently accept Jesus' radical yet substantiated _____ that confirm His _____ (8:30). *Many who heard Jesus' substantiated claim believed. If we do the same, we will experience radical consequences. Our passage mentions several.*
