- Minister: How does baptism remind you and assure you that Christ's one sacrifice on the cross is for you personally?
- In this way: Christ instituted this outward washing People: and with it gave the promise that, as surely as water washes away the dirt from the body, so certainly His blood and His Spirit wash away my soul's impurity, in other words, all my sins.
- Minister: Should infants, too, be baptized?

People: Yes. Infants as well as adults are in God's covenant and are His people. They, no less than adults, are promised the forgiveness of sin through Christ's blood and the Holy Spirit Who produces faith. Therefore, by baptism, the mark of the covenant, infants should be received into the Christian Church and should be distinguished from the children of unbelievers. This was done in the Old Testament by circumcision, which was replaced in the New Testament by baptism.
