ATTENDANCE AND TARDIES: We have noticed an increase in tardies in our school over the past few weeks. Please be reminded that students are required, by state law, to be in attendance with clearly defined parameters. Being "absent from school" includes time that is missed due to being tardy. Please review:

"Illinois law requires children ages six to 17 to attend public school, with some exceptions, including children attending a private or parochial school or children being homeschooled where certain requirements are met.

A child may not be absent from a public school without valid cause for 5 percent or more of the previous 180 regular attendance days, or 9 days. Prior to 2011, Illinois law prohibited a child from being absent from a public school for 10 percent or more of the previous 180 regular attendance days, or 18 days. Valid cause is defined as illness, observance of a religious holiday, death in the immediate family or a family emergency."

<u>TARDY NOTE (IMPORTANT)</u>: if your child is tardy, they MUST be accompanied by an adult and brought into the school office. We have an open campus where anyone can walk across our courtyard and parents must supervise the safety of students and bring them into the school office.
