REGISTRATIONS: If you have not done so yet, please turn in your 2017-2018 school year registrations to our office. The new Registration Fee is only \$50. To secure your spot for next year, you only need to pay the \$50 Registration Fee. That needs to be paid as soon as possible. All the other fees have been combined into one fee now that is called the Materials Fee. This fee is prorated to offer a discount to families that pay earlier, rather than later. This fee is due to the school office by June 1st. (FYI, all Registration Fees and Materials Fees must be paid in order for your child to begin school in August.) If you pay this fee in March, it is \$250; if you pay in April, it moves up to \$300; and if you pay in May or later, it is \$350. As you can see, there is a considerable discount for paying the Materials Fee early.
