MEDICAL, DENTAL, VISION EXAMS DEADLINE: State Law requires that certain grade levels of school children receive medical, dental, and vision exams by September 20th. If your child has not completed their exam and brought in the paperwork from your doctor by September 20th, then they will not be allowed in school. This is required for the safety and well being of all our students. We really don't want to tell a student that they cannot come to school, so please make sure you have completed the required exams and submitted the proper documentation. The following grade levels must complete their exams: HEALTH: Preschool, Kindergarten, 6th, and new students - VISION: Kindergarten, any out of state student - DENTAL: Kindergarten, 2nd, 6th grades.
