### QUEST KIDS CLUB VOCABULARY

**SQUADS:** Kids are divided up into age groups (K-1, 2-4, 5-6) and assigned to a leader. They will do homework with their squads and check in with their squad leader throughout the afternoon. Squads will also compete against each other throughout the year (see squad awards\*)

**DEVO:** Short for devotion. During snack on Tuesdays and Thursdays, a QKC staffer will share a short devotion with a character development lesson involved.

**FREE PLAY:** QKC is full of games, recreation equipment, a playground, computer lab, and so much more. During Free Time, kids will be allowed to choose and change up where they want to play. QKC staffers will be spread among each area during these times.

**QUEST AWARDS:** Every month kids will be competing against each other to get points for their squad. Points can be awarded for good grades, memorizing their Bible verses, getting caught being helpful, and also through the occasional recreation games! At the end of each month QKC staff will name the MVP for each squad as well as awarding different prizes or privileges to the leading squad for that month. FUN FRIDAY: Let's be honest, the last thing any of us want to do on Friday afternoon is homework. That's why Fridays at QKC are FUN! Starting with Squad Awards and going to rec games, free play, and fun surprises! **DISMISSAL:** Kids can be picked up any time after 3:45 (preferably), but they must be picked up by 6pm or we will charge \$1 for every minute they are late being picked up. # PAYMENTS

• If your child is registered for the full week, you must pay the full \$50/week even if your child does not attend after school club due to sickness or vacation.

• If your child is registered for only specified days each week, you are responsible for paying \$12 for every day they are signed up for even if your child does not attend after school club due to sickness or vacation.

• If your child is on scholarship you must pay the required fee on time even if your child misses due to sickness or vacation. If payments are not paid on time, there is a chance you may lose your scholarship.

## •Payments are due every other Monday. You can also pay for the entire month on the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of the month if you would like. On these days you can park and come in to the check-in desk to pay your fees.

- •There will be no refunds or excused payments unless Quest Kids Club is closed.
- If a payment is not paid on time there will be \$5 added for each day it is late.
- You can pay with check, cash, or debit card (via Square).
- Checks should be made to Quest Kids Club.
- If you have questions at any time, please feel free to ask Kari or another staffer!

### **SNACKS**

Quest Kids Club will provide a snack for children each afternoon. We will also provide ice water. If your child would like to purchase a soda, they will need to bring 50¢ for the Coke machine. Kids are allowed to bring their own snacks and drinks in their backpacks.

## TRANSPORTATION

Kennedy Elementary and Williams Intermediate will be dropped off at QKC by the Pell City School Busses. The bus pulls right to our front door where a staffer will be waiting for the children. Coosa Valley Elementary and Iola Elementary share a QKC bus, which will be driven by a QKC staffer. Lincoln Elementary & Eden Elementary are also be picked up by a QKC bus and staffer. Drivers will make sure that every child is present before leaving the schools, so **please be sure to call us if your child will not be riding.**

To ensure the safety of every child, parents will not be allowed inside Quest Kids Club during the 3pm-6pm club hours, unless otherwise noted. Parents will be given 2 window cards with a number for your child(ren). As shown below, please form a "carpool line" facing the Backyard. Please place your Window Card in your windshield so that it is visible. As your car approaches the main entrance, a staffer will call your child(ren)'s names to come outside. Kids may get into vehicles as long as their number is on the window card. Please make sure that if someone else is picking up your child that they are on your pickup list and have your window card. We'd love for you to send a note and let us know if someone other than a parent is picking up a child that afternoon.



If a child is not picked up by 6pm, QKC will charge you \$1 for every minute you are late. Please be respectful of our staff, and make this happen. If for some reason you are running late and know you won't be on time please call and let us know. If you are running late and can arrange for someone else to pick your children up, that is fine, but please call and let us know if they don't have a QKC window card. If someone other than a parent is picking up a child they MUST be on the pick up list that you filled out at registration.

### **RULES FOR KIDS**

- 2. Stay with squad and where you are supposed to be at all times.
- 3. Be nice to everyone and keep your hands to yourself.

### **DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES**

The goal of discipline is to help children manage their own behaviors. To achieve this goal, the children will be in a stimulating environment with materials and activities suited to meet their appropriate age and developmental abilities. Campers will be expected to demonstrate respect for one another, Quest Kids Club staff, and equipment at all times.

### The following behaviors are inappropriate and will result in consequences for the child:

- Aggressive, physical behavior/fighting, and/or excessive physical contact
- Defiance of authority
- Disruptive and out of control behavior
- Lack of consideration and rudeness towards other children and staff
- Inappropriate school behavior/language

#### Consequences in successive order:

- The child's behavior and impact upon themselves and others will be discussed with them by one of the Quest Kids Club staff members -Removal from activity/time out/child will be redirected

-Child will be given Bible verses to write that have to do with the inappropriate behavior

- Written/verbal notification and explanation of situation and behavior to the parent/guardian

- Parent conference with Quest Kids Club squad leader and Director to develop a behavior plan/contract

-Suspension from Quest Kids Club (length of time to be determined at time of suspension)

\*Parents/guardians will immediately be notified if the child's behavior endangers their safety, the safety of other children or the safety of the staff. \*Quest Kids Club takes pride in promoting positive behavior through recognition and positive reinforcement.
