FIELD TRIPS

We have scheduled multiple field trips for the summer, which can be found on the last page. Field trips are an additional cost, but are not required. If you wish that your child not attend a field trip that is scheduled for their group, they are welcome to stay at Quest with the other squads.

LUNCH

Parents are responsible for sending a lunch with their child Monday-Thursday. <u>PLEASE DO</u> <u>NOT SEND ANYTHING THAT NEEDS TO BE HEATED UP.</u> We will provide pizza every Friday for the kids. QKC will supply a drink for lunch if needed, and the Coke machine will be opened (sodas are 50¢). Please make sure to put your child's name on their lunch bag.

SNACK

We will provide a snack and water/lemonade each afternoon.

MEDICINE

If your child is on any kind of medicine that will need to be taken while at QKC, or if you'd like to leave some Motrin/Tylenol/etc., you must put it in a zip lock bag and fill out a Medicine Form.

SUNSCREEN

We will be outside most days, please send your child with sunscreen already on. We will not supply sunscreen and staffers can't take the time to help kids put it on every time we go outside. However, you may put it in their bag, and if we notice they are getting red we will put more on them.

DRESS CODE

Shorts and a t-shirt or tank top are perfect for kids to wear to camp! Our main concern is shoes... we ask that you please send your child in tennis shoes or some kind of closed-in shoe. This is for their own safety. We do a lot of games and playing outside, and we don't want any stumped toes! For water day we will ask that you send your child in their swimsuit with a shirt or cover up over it, a bag with a towel, and a change of clothes. This is the only day kids can wear flip flops or sandals!

PATING

Unfortunately our website doesn't have the capability to pay online right now. Your payment for the week is due every Monday morning. You may park and come in the main entrance and a staffer will be there to take your payments and give you a receipt. You may also pay for the upcoming week on Fridays at pick up. You can write a check to Quest Kids Club. Pay in cash, or swipe your card via Square©. If you don't pay by that time you will be billed and an additional \$10 will be added per a child to that bill for every day that it is not paid. We are a non-profit organization and we depend on the payments for campers to stay opened.

**If your child is on scholarship, your payment must be paid on Monday by 6pm or your child will not be able to participate in QKC and your scholarship will be given to another family.

\$100 a week per child and \$80 for each additional sibling.

Early Show is an additional \$10/week and Late Show is an additional \$5/week.

We do allow children to come by the day, but it will be \$30/day.

Field trips are not included in these prices and children are not required to attend field trips.

QUEST KIDS CLUB VOCABULARY

TRIBES: Kids will be divided into one of two large tribes for the summer. They will compete in rec games, the Bible Quest Game Show, and many more activities with their tribe! The tribe with the most points at the end of each week wins! **SQAUADS:** Squads are the most important part of camp! Kids are in age and gender divided groups with a leader. They will do devotion and travel through track times with these groups!

WAKE UP CALL: Monday – Thursday we will kick off our mornings with silly games, funny jokes, dancing, skits, and tons of great fun!

CELEBRATION: Monday – Thursday kids will participate in a time of worship through music and teaching! We will sing a few songs and watch the Bible lesson video for each day!

REC: Kids will participate in organized outdoor games (weather permitting)! **TRACK ROTATIONS:** Kids will travel with their squads to different tracks each day: art, lunch, devotion, study shack, computer, chill time, backyard, explore, and snack.

EXPLORE: This track will be different each day and will go along with the theme of the week. For example, for our undercover kindness theme we will do projects, and games during Explore that have to do with acts of kindness or even spy activities!

CHILL TIME: Kids will be in the chill zone and may read, play board games, or just rest!

STUDY SHACK: We have talked to teachers in our area and put together some packets for kids to complete during the Study Shack track time. This will not be an intensive review or teaching time, but just a short worksheet to keep things fresh and prepare kids for their upcoming school year. They will have time to read after finishing their math sheet.

THE WRAP: Each day we will come back together and recap the day with the kids. They will have an opportunity to share something they learned or their favorite thing they did. We will also announce our camper of the day and which tribe is in the lead for Tribe of the Week!

WACKY WEDNESDAY: Every Wednesday, kids are invited to get creative and dress up for the theme that week. We will choose the "QKC Best Dressed" on this day... prizes and points will even be up for grabs!

BIBLE QUEST GAME SHOW: It's just like it sounds! Tribes will compete in a Game Show on Friday morning to test their knowledge of everything they have been learning that week! This is just a fun way to review our lessons from the week and see how much the kids have learned.

CAMPER OF THE DAY: The staffers will choose one camper each day based on their excitement, kindness, participation, and good choices, to be the camper of the day! They will be recognized at the wrap and then again at wake up call the following day.

RULES FOR KIDS

- 1. Obey and respect your leaders.
- 2. Stay with squad and where you are supposed to be at all times.
- 3. Be nice to everyone and keep your hands to yourself.
- 4. Follow the rules in each Track room.
- 5. Have fun!

DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES

The goal of discipline is to help children manage their own behaviors. In order to achieve this goal, the children will be in a stimulating environment with materials and activities suited to meet their appropriate age and developmental abilities. Campers will be expected to demonstrate respect for one another, Quest Kids Club staff, and equipment at all times.

The following behaviors are inappropriate and will result in consequences for the child:

- Aggressive, physical behavior/fighting, and/or excessive physical contact
- Defiance of authority
- Disruptive and out of control behavior
- Lack of consideration and rudeness towards other children and staff
- Inappropriate school behavior/language

Consequences in successive order:

- 1. The camper's behavior and impact upon themselves and others will be discussed with them by one of the Quest Kids Club staff members
- 2. Removal from activity/time out/child will be redirected
- 3. Children will be given Bible verses to write based on whatever rule they broke.
- 4. Written/verbal notification and explanation of situation and behavior to the parent/guardian
- 5. Suspension from Quest Kids Club (length of time to be determined at time of suspension)

*Parents/guardians will immediately be notified if the child's behavior endangers their safety, the safety of other children or the safety of the staff. *Quest Kids Club takes pride in promoting positive behavior through recognition and positive reinforcement.

DROP OFF & PICK UP


To ensure the safety of every child, parents will only be allowed as far as the front desk at Quest Kids Club during the 7am-6pm camp hours, unless otherwise noted. Parents will be given 2 window cards with your child(ren)'s name on it. As shown below, please form a "carpool line" facing the Backyard. Kids may enter through the main entrance each morning. Parents may then loop their cars to the left in the back of the parking lot to exit. For pick up, parents should line up the same way and place their window cards in their windshield. As they are approaching the main entrance a staffer will call their names to come outside. Kids may get into vehicles as long as their number is on the window card. Please make sure that if someone else is picking up your child that they are on your pickup list and have your window card. We'd love for you to send a note and let us know if someone other than a parent is picking up a child that afternoon.

- Drop off for Early Show begins at 7am
- Drop off will continue until 9:00

- Doors will be locked at 9:20 – If you drop off after this you will need to call 205-338-7543 for a staffer to come unlock the door.

- Pick up begins at 4:45 and children must be picked up by 5pm (or 6pm Late Show)

**If a child is not picked up by 6pm, QKC will charge you \$5 for every 5 minutes you are late.
