## Good news for Feed

My People (FMP) donors in Jefferson and St. Louis Counties. Missouri The legislature has approved the Food Pantry Tax Credit for 2013. To be eligible for the Credit, a taxpayer must have made a donation of cash and/or food supplies to a food distributes pantry that emergency food supplies to low-income people in the area the taxpayer claiming the tax credit resides. Each taxpayer may take a credit of 50 percent of their donations up to \$2,500 per taxpayer per Your credit may not exceed your tax liability. To claim the credit you
