Thanks for Caring!

Many donors do not realize the impact their contributions make to our clients. Several cases come to mind. One particular one occurred last year when a husband of 3 broke his back children consequently lost his job, insurance, home, and automobile. His wife then was diagnosed with C.O.P.D., and has been trying to find any type of job she can while trying to take care of everyone else in the family. So far she is helping a woman with M.S. and making a small salary. She told me that if it wasn't for the generosity of Feed My People, her family would not be eating nor have school supplies, shoe certificates, and clothing. We have been her "Angels of Mercy".

Another very touching story has been unfolding for the past 4 years. A man was diagnosed with Black Lung and was coping with this when his mid-thirty year old daughter was diagnosed with terminal cancer. This gentleman then moved into her home to help with his 16 year old grandchild living with Downs Syndrome. His health continued to deteriorate so quickly, that he suffered a stroke and his oldest grandchildren moved in to take care of him. His daughter is now in the last stages of cancer and he just died last month. Our interviewers continually talked to him and listened to him as well as comforted him. We are now trying to help this family cope with everything, and continue to feed them and listen to their story and especially lead them to the right places to get other help. The husband is working two part-time jobs to try to pay the bills and the enormous hospital bills. Many of us cried when we heard one of our favorite clients had died. After he received his gifts from the Adopt-A-Family Program, he would cry and keep saying "I have been so blessed by the generosity of your donors, and I will never be able to repay them for helping me through these difficult times.'

These are just a few of the many catastrophes your monetary contributions are used for. A big thank you goes out to each and every one of you daily by our clients – you just don't know it.


