A Word from the Pastors

War Cry

Isa 62:6 I have set watchmen upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which shall never hold their peace day nor night: ye that make mention of the Lord, keep not silence,

The enemy of our souls is waging a silent war against the church of Jesus Christ and has adapted a strategic method that is so subtle that the church can easily forget who we are in God and fall victims to the enemies deceitful tactics. God has set us upon the wall as watchmen in this earth and our duty is to cry out and sound the alarm, warning His people in times of trouble. Just as Christ warned in Matthew 24, we are living in days characterized by increased deception and wickedness. The Church of Jesus Christ cannot be lulled to sleep and except the attacks of our enemy as normal part of life. Satan knows the biblical signs of Christ's imminent return far better than we do, and he is furious because he knows his time is short. *Rev. 12:12 Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! For the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.* So as the world shakes, fear grips the hearts of millions and other perplexing problems seem to crop up anew every day; the church must realize that political systems are not the answer and realize that our fight is not natural but supernatural. We must look beyond the surface and see that demonic forces have been released to destroy us and we must begin acting according to the Word of God. A war of unprecedented proportions is waging against the church and the people of God. We must put on our armor, learn how to use our weapons, and fight with the confidence of those who know they are destined to win.

We are a church at war. A Church that cannot forget that Jesus fights for us. We must remember the words of the Apostle Paul in *Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.* This is not a physical battle and it is imperative that we use spiritual weapons. All believers must train to become Biblical warriors and act like the saints of old, who immersed themselves in prayer. They looked to Jesus for everything and because of this they were able to move mountains. Jesus called His church "the House of Prayer" because prayer is the most powerful weapon in our arsenal, yet so many Christians have little to no prayer life. We are simply too busy and self-absorbed. God is sounding an alarm! He is directing us as He directed the Israelites, to blow the trumpet and sound an alarm when they go up against their enemies, He is calling His church to engage in Biblical warfare. The call through Joel from God was universal and no one was excluded. There is a cry that God is waiting to hear in His ears from His People. It is a cry of war and victory that will lose shackles and defeat the enemies in our life. This is War and it is time for the saints of God to release their War Cry which releases God to defeat our enemy. During this consecration and fast we will consider the following:

Our pastor declares "Lift your voice in high praise to God!" As you make a joyful noise, be assured that your worship is releasing the hosts of heaven to accomplish the will of God on earth as it is in heaven.

JCFANS PRAYER PAPER for the next six weeks are included with this journal. You will find your prayer papers for the upcoming weeks in the back of your journal. These papers will give you directives for our corporate praying. Take these papers as your "marching orders" for the weeks ahead. As we march in step as a body of believers we will shake the foundations of darkness and put many to flight.

It is imperative that we incorporate prayer with our fasting. In James, it is declared that "the effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much." When a body of believers fueled by the Holy Spirit respond to God's invitation to fast and pray, miracles happen. **You may find these tips helpful:**

- ◆ Refer to the **Fast Schedule** for food selections and 24-hour fast days.
- ◆ Turn off your TV during the fast.

Why Fast? Here Are 18 Important Reasons!

Fasting is a time of placing the desires of the flesh under the desires of the spirit by denying the body natural food and drink. It is God's will that all saints fast and pray, and His reward is granted to those who do. You will never again feel the defeat of failing to fast when you discover the importance and benefits of consecrated fasting to Jesus.

Fasting...

1. Removes pride, self-righteousness and envy, and it humbles the soul.
2. Reveals doubt and unbelief and removes it. Faith is let loose and your reasoning's (evidence of your senses) are cast down. II Cor 10:3-5
3. Brings you face to face with reality and increases your spiritual discernment. This fuels the effectiveness of your praying and sees your unanswered prayers answered. Mat 17:21; Ps. 35:13
4. It is self-chastisement and prevents many chastisements of the Lord. It will stay the hand of judgment.
5. Pleases your spirit by mortifying your flesh. It revives [holy] spiritual power and gives man favor with God and mankind. Lk 4:14
6. Breaks bad habits by consuming their roots, which are embedded in the stomach. (i.e. tobacco, drug, alcohol, caffeine and sugar habits) It also removes the lust hunger and overstuffing habits. Lk 21:34; Ps 78
7. Slows carnality, placing unnatural desires in a dormant condition. It also consumes and burns out roots of fleshly lusts. Rev 2:7; Col 3:5
8. Develops Fruit of the Spirit and self-control in all things (i.e. impatience, intemperance, rage, ungratefulness, nervousness, restlessness, indifference, slothfulness, anxiety, unforgiveness, fear, unfaithfulness, greed, etc.)
9. Brings wisdom in raising your children and in pleasing your spouse.
10. Gives child of God spiritual manifestations and releases God's power, glory and anointing to accomplish His will. Manifests spiritual gifts.
11. Releases visions, revelations, and better understanding of the bible.
12. It's the quickest and greatest curative and disease preventive known to man, outside of divine healing. This happens by simply starving out the ailment; i.e. ridding the body of poisonous filth, food decay, excess mucus, and fecal matter, all of which invite disease and DEMONS. It rests, improves, prevents and overcomes heart trouble, melon sized tumors, ulcers, cancers, goiters, arthritis, colitis; and boils, skin blemishes, indigestion, dyspepsia, autointoxication, asthma, fever, constipation, anemia, migraines, insomnia, infertility, menopause, rheumatism.
13. Causes an automatic blood transfusion. This improves circulation, purifies the blood, cleanses and unclogs blood vessels, and bathes the organs.
14. Restores beauty, grace, charm, and normalizes female functions. It also prolongs life, sparks mental clarity and improves sensory awareness.
15. Gives all body parts rest and revitalization. It also returns the stomach and intestinal tract to normal size.. Smaller tummy, less food, more money.
16. Conserves energy. The housecleaning effect of fasting leaves you feeling tired and sluggish while the worst toxins and poisons are being removed. If a headache arises, it is a sure sign that you needed to fast. As your fast continues, your strength is renewed day by day, especially after day 10-15.
17. Eradicates the foul, bad tasting mouth. Fresher breath is a pleasing result.
18. Undoes ungodly decisions and national corruption. Es 4:1-17; Act 13:2

2 Tim 4:17 Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me; that by me the preaching might be fully known, and that all the Gentiles might hear: and I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion.

The Art of War

Rev 16:14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

We are at war against the kingdom of darkness. This war is a state of armed conflict between God's children and the darkness of this world. The Church of Jesus Christ is in a state of conflict with the ideology and systems of this world that are aggressively undermining the laws and principles of God. The enemy has declared war against the church and our response should be to declare war on his war against us. *Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.* The battle ground of this conflict is fought in the minds of God's people but Jesus has already won the war. The battle that we fight is for our very souls and for the souls of those we love. (Rev 17:14) The Church must be strategic in its approach to our conflict and uphold the law of God in every battle. Much can be gleaned from a classic work by Sun Tzu, "The Art of War." It talks about the strategies of war and mentions five factors that every soldier must know to win. These are (1) The Moral Law (2) Heaven (3) Earth (4) The Commander (5) Method and discipline. If we apply the Bible to these factors we will find our strategies of war. The Moral Law, or the Bible causes the people to be in complete accord with their ruler, so that they will follow Jesus regardless of their trials; and be unmoved by any danger that confronts them. Heaven signifies the entire purpose of our fight, that we might make it into His glorious kingdom. Earth is the realm in which we must overcome where devils are waging war, trying to stop us from fulfilling our purpose in God. Our commander is the Lord Jesus Christ in all of His wisdom and knowledge, whom we trust to fight all of our battles. Our methodology and discipline are the weapons of our warfare which we use to continue the crucifixion of all of our fleshly lust and desires. According to Daniel the prophet the enemy is trying to wear us out. (Dan 7:25) Jesus Himself told us that the enemy desires to have us and sift us as wheat. (Luke 22:31) The weapon that will strengthen us to win this war, that crucifies our flesh and transforms us into His image; is the powerful Word of God that will lead us to an amazing victory when we fight with it.

Week Two Theme:

Fighting with the Word of God

Rev 2:16 Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

There is a war going on somewhere in the world constantly. The people of God are going through battles every day. It is not of a physical but of a spiritual nature. We are constantly having to choose between right and wrong and at times we become weary. It is in those times of weariness that we forget about the Word of God and allow our weapon, the sword of the spirit to become dull and ineffective. Sun Tzu says in "The Art of War," "When you engage in actual fighting, if victory is long in coming, then men's weapons will grow dull and their ardor will be damped." When our weapons are dull, ineffective and ineffective in the fight; the battle will go the enemies way. This is the reason we should remain in Gods word day and night. The word is our greatest offense weapon. It is the sword of the Spirit and helps us to defeat every demonic attack in our life. We are commanded to be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might that we can stand against the enemy of our soul. As an offensive weapon, the sword was used to attack an enemy until the weapon seriously wounded or killed the assailant. In order to defeat the enemy in battle a soldier must be skillful in handling his sword. In fact, if you do not know how to use the sword, you will be killed by the enemy easily. To win a spiritual battle, you must study the Word of God until it becomes a part of your existence. The Bible says, do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth. (2 Timothy 2:15) Please remember that the devil used the word of God to attack Jesus. But Jesus knew appropriate scriptures to counter the devil because, He was the Word made flesh. To be able to be that skillful, you must spend many hours learning the scriptures. We must learn to meditate on the word of God and memorize it so that we can quote the scriptures when temptation comes. We cannot become weary in the battle. When we hide His word in our heart, obey it and love it more than life; it will become a weapon in our mouth and we will win. We may have trials and disappointments and it may seem like we are losing the battle, but it is certain, that we will win the war through the Word of God.

Losing a Battle but Winning the War

Josh 7:12 Therefore the children of Israel could not stand before their enemies, but turned their backs before their enemies, because they were accursed: neither will I be with you any more, except ye destroy the accursed from among you.

The distance between a great victory and a great defeat is only one step, and often only a short one at that. One sad truth is that we can be riding high on the cloud of some great spiritual success and the very next moment find ourselves in a valley of spiritual failure and despair. One moment we can be like Elijah standing victoriously on Mount Carmel and the next shriveled up under a juniper tree or hiding in a cave in deep despair complaining to God: "... I am the only one left, and now they are trying to kill me too" (1 Kings 19:10). One of the major problems in the Church is that oftentimes we lack purpose and direction and we underestimate the evil plan of our enemy. The trials of life often take us by surprise and immobilize us to the point that many have given up the fight and returned to their old way of life. We must remember that the enemy of our souls is going up and down in the earth seeking whom he may devour. This is war and he is not playing fair. He will use anything and anyone to destroy our faith and to turn our attention from God to his demonic plan. The children of Israel were riding high after their victory at Jericho and it caused them to become self reliant and proud when they came up against a seemingly weaker city at Ai. Even though they were on a campaign of victory, the sin of the accursed thing brought defeat at the battle of Ai. When they defeated Jericho and caused the walls to fall down, they followed the plan and voice of God explicitly. But at Ai, they didn't consider God, devised their own strategy and as a result were defeated by a weaker enemy. We will lose every battle that we fight if we don't eliminate sin and seek the Lord for His strategic plan and direction. We may not have won every battle in our life but we are assured that we will win the war, because our God will fight for us. He has already defeated His enemy. Remember, God doesn't always give us good but the bad comes to us also. He is a good father who blesses us and matures us in the fiery furnace of affliction. (Isa 48:10) We win the war by understanding the mind of God concerning us. We have a guaranteed victory when we trust Him and through it all He teaches us the principle of crying out to Him.

The Power of Crying Out

Ps 18:6 In my distress I called upon the Lord, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, even unto his ears.

Throughout time, the people of God have cried out to Him in times of trouble. Many times it seems as if we have prayed for years and nothing happens. In these times a single cry brings instant direction or deliverance from God. The Lord made us a promise in the scriptures that if we cried out to Him in times of trouble that He would deliver us. (Psalm 50:15) God is waiting to hear us cry out for His help in the time of trouble. Our cry is the only thing that God will respond to in our deepest need. Throughout the Scripture, we are instructed to cry out to God in times of distress, and we have many examples of the delivering power of our cry. In Jeremiah 33:3 he declared "Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not". In psalm 34:17 He says that the righteous cry, and the Lord heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles". Our cry helps us to win battles and ultimately the war. *Psalm 56:9 When I cry unto thee, then shall mine enemies turn back: this I know; for God is for me.* Our God is for us and He is listening for our cry. Crying out to God expresses our genuine humility. It is hard for us to admit that we cannot solve a problem or overcome an obstacle, but it is true that we need our Fathers help. Our cry also expresses our unconditional surrender to God. When a situation becomes so desperate that only God can deliver you, a cry represents total, unconditional surrender because we realize that we can do nothing without Him. *John 15:5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.* Our cry to God acknowledges God's ability to do what no one else can do. During the storm on the Sea of Galilee, the disciples acknowledged Jesus' power to rescue them when they cried out, "Lord, save us: we perish" in Matthew 8:25. Crying out to God is an admission of our total dependency and need for God. The psalmist declared, in "Psalm 18:6 In my distress I called upon the Lord, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, even into his ears". As we cry out to the Lord, He will set us up as watchmen over our families, churches, lost souls and the nations.

Neh 4:9 Nevertheless we made our prayer unto our God, and set a watch against them day and night, because of them.

Watchmen Sound the Alarm

Ezek 3:17 Son of man, I have made thee a watchman unto the house of Israel: therefore hear the word at my mouth, and give them warning from me.

The Bible uses the role of a watchman to describe the work of a prophet among God's people. The role of the watchman is vital in this hour since people are in need of a word from God. We automatically think of those in church leadership when we consider the role of the watchman but in the New Testament that responsibility to watch goes beyond our pastors. It is assembly leaders job to watch for the house of God, but all those that know God have a duty to watch and pray for their sphere of influence; that includes the church, friends and family. The natural by-product of our close relationship with God is being alert to religious deception and false teaching. The end result of fulfilling the role of a watchman within the Body of Christ is to be found standing in the end sounding the alarm for the coming of Jesus. This is a time for the watchman to mount the walls and sound a clear, unmistakable warning message of the dangers facing this generation and their need for salvation. Gods main message throughout the Bible is to return to His paths, His teachings, as the solution for suffering and pain of human life. *Isa 58:1 Cry aloud, spare not, lift up thy voice like a trumpet, and shew my people their transgression, and the house of Jacob their sins.* In the days of Nehemiah, when the wall was being rebuilt, there were gaps in the wall that were called exposed places. They were areas where the enemy could come in and attack. The Lord told us in Ezekial 33:6 that the watchmen should sound the alarm to warn the people of His impending judgement. The watchmen in this hour must be able to hear from God in order to sound the alarm and help the church to fix all the exposed places in our life. These areas will cause all of our weaknesses to be exposed that the enemy would love to exploit. Nehemiah sounded the alarm and encouraged everyone to watch and be on guard. We must be on guard and realize that our exposed places will cause us to be weak in battle. Some of God's people have problems with greed and the pleasures of this world. Some with lust. Some with pride and some with fear. Whatever our exposed places are, be aware that that is an area that the enemy would like to exploit. So we must be on watch. We saw in the Old Testament, that watchmen were men of Israel assigned a particular task of watching from the walls of Jerusalem. We also saw that spiritually speaking, the leaders and elders of Israel were called watchmen because they watch, guard and care for the souls of God's people. God has commanded us to watch and pray that we enter not into temptation.

War Cry

Josh 6:16 And it came to pass at the seventh time, when the priests blew with the trumpets, Joshua said unto the people, Shout; for the Lord hath given you the city.

The Victory is in My Shout

1 Sam 4:5 And when the ark of the covenant of the Lord came into the camp, all Israel shouted with a great shout, so that the earth rang again.

2 Chron 13:15 Then the men of Judah gave a shout: and as the men of Judah shouted, it came to pass, that God smote Jeroboam and all Israel before Abijah and Judah.

Can you imagine a picture of an ancient warrior that lifts his sword and rushes into battle, crying out the name of his God. His war-cry is like the sound of a trumpet that pierces through the heavens and the earth while he is sounding his alarm and declaring victory over his enemies. We release a sound into the earth that declares our victory. *"Num 10:9 And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be remembered before the Lord your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies.* God's people are warriors who confidently rush into battle, because we hear our commander saying: "I am the first, and I am the last; and **beside me there is no God.** ... FEAR YE NOT, NEITHER BE AFRAID ..." (Isa 44:6-8) Our God has confirmed in His word that He has defeated all our enemies. *"Behold, they shall surely gather together, but not by me: who-soever shall gather together against thee shall fall for thy sake ... No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn."* (Isa 54:13-17) Our War Cry is not a call for help it is a cry of victory, knowing that we win every battle through our God that loves us. It's the Shout that brought down the walls of Jericho when God gave them the city. Sometimes the victory is right in front of us, sometimes it's hard for us to see where the battle has been won. The dictionary definition of War Cry means a phrase or saying that is used to make people support an idea, a cause, or a cry used by a body of fighters in war. The scriptures share a time that the children were at war with the Philistines and when the ark of the covenant of the Lord came into the camp, they shouted with a War Cry and caused the enemy to fear for their lives. (1Sam 4:5-9) Even the enemy knows when God is with us. As we gather together under the banner of God let us always be mindful to release our battle cry. When times get hard release your War Cry. The cry that celebrates our victory over the enemy. We have battles yet to fight but we will Shout the Victory at every trial and distress of our life. Our God is Great and He lives for ever. Therefore, we have the victory. This is our War Cry!

Breaking your Fast

We ask that you take caution in breaking your fast. **PLEASE BREAK YOUR FAST SLOWLY!!!!** Make wise choices when selecting your first meals. You have purged your body of filthy toxins and excess, trapped wastes, and it would be a shame to undo all your efforts. Refer to the back page of the fast book to better understand what your fasting has provided you. Then, refer to the directions below to help you break your fast carefully. Understand that how you break your fast is extremely important for your physical and spiritual well-being. Gradually ending your fast maintains its beneficial effects and it results in continual, good, overall health.

- Before eating anything, have a glass of water or fruit/Vegetable juice to prepare your body to receive food. Continue drinking water.
- Choose a small meal or snack. Stick to raw salads, soups, steamed vegetables, fruits or a small baked potato without the added toppings.
- Then, preferably the next day, **SLOWLY** reintroduce more complex meal choices: vegetable soup and baked sweet potato with butter; broiled fish and salad. Gradually return to a normal diet, choosing healthy, wholesome meals and snacks.

DO NOT EAT HEAVY SOLID FOODS immediately after your fast. Doing so will likely have negative, even dangerous consequences. Your body is the temple of God – be gentle to your stomach and digestive tract.

Our Mission: Sharing our Faith in Jesus Christ

As you embark upon your journey of consecration, you will find many opportunities to share your faith with others. Fasting and Prayer usually serves as a magnet that will draw hungry souls to the Christ in you. The followings is a step-by-step guideline to win souls to Jesus for salvation. As the scripture declares, we must have a reasonable answer for the hope that lies within us.

Five Steps to Lead a Person to Jesus Christ

Step 1

They should acknowledge that they are sinners and need a savior.

Have them repeat after you:

“I know that I am a sinner and that I am in need of a savior.”

Step 2

They should confess with their mouth that they want Jesus with all their heart. When a soul is able to confess this fact, it is usually an indication of repentance. Encourage them to let this come from their heart.

Step 3

Remember salvation is a journey. Once they have acknowledged their need for Jesus, pray the following prayer with them to receive direction for the next step:

Dear Lord Jesus, Thank you for allowing me to see how much I need you in my life. I have lived a total life of sin and am now making the decision to come to you. Lord, thank you for your call on my life as I pray that you direct me toward your plan and salvation.

Step 4

Compel them to join you in one of our weekly Bible Studies or invite them to join you in studying about the plan of God for salvation.

Step 5

Share with them God’s only plan of Salvation as recorded in the book of Acts. Share with them that the next step is theirs. Share the Lord’s plan of salvation with them that follows:

Gods' Only Plan of Salvation: What Must I do to be Saved?

FOUR STEPS

John 3:3-8 - Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is lesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

Acts 2:38-40 - Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call. And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Acts 8:12 But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.

Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Step Four:

Live a Holy and Sanctified Life before the Lord Go on to Know Him

Gal 5:24-25 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Rom 8:10 And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

2 Cor 3:6 Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life. **1 Peter 4:6** For this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.

Rom 8:4-5 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

Gal 5:16-18 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

Rom 6:19 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

Rom 6:22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.

2 Cor 7:1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

Eph 4:24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

1 Thess 3:13 To the end he may establish your hearts unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints.

1 Thess 4:7 For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.

Titus 2:3 The aged women likewise, that they be in behavior as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

Heb 12:10 For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness.

Heb 12:14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:
