## A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR


*Grace* be unto you.

### **Stewards Ministry**

### **Transportation Ministry**

They are responsible for providing continued checks on the mechanical operation, safety, cleanliness, and fuel levels of all transportation equipment.

### **Ushers Ministry**

They are responsible for directing the entry of worshippers, the flow of givers, making certain that Bibles, church literature, offering envelopes and other items that need to be distributed are in their proper places, and other direction as necessary.

**Prayer Ministry**

This ministry undergirds all aspects of the church, as it encourages members to grow in loving fellowship through a meaningful life of prayer. It seeks to follow the teaching of Jesus that lead them into a personal relationship with the Lord.

**Seniors Ministry**

This ministry involves members aged 62 and older, who gather for fellowship, discipleship, and activities that inspire, educate, inform, entertain, and foster a Christian community.

**Special Events Ministry**

This ministry is responsible for the coordination, planning, design and set-up for a variety of church wide events and special projects within the calendar year. They strive to organize fun and entertaining celebrations that foster growth and fellowship among the members and guests.

#### **Ministry of the Worship Arts**

This Ministry exist to glorify God by discerning the flow of the Holy Spirit through artistic expressions to engage the body of Christ in preparation to receive the Word of God. It has oversight of the following:

**Drama Ministry** utilizes people's God-given talents to bring Scriptures to life through the creative expressions of those who write, act, dance, play a musical instrument, or sing, with a willing spirit and evangelical heart.

**Mass Choir** is a compilation of all choirs ministering a unified sound to usher the congregation into the presence of the Lord through song.

**MIME Ministry** ministers the Word of God through the art of interpretative movement set to music using physical movements with hands and bodies.

**Praise Dance Ministry** offers reverence to the Lord through the God-given expressions of dance and liturgical movement.

**Praise and Worship Ministry** facilitates the worship experience by creating an atmosphere where the presence of the Lord is central and enjoins people into a celebration through the Holy Spirit.

**Voices of Praise Choir** represents senior saints who celebrate and worship the Lord through song.

**Youth Choirs** represent two age groups, 3-12 and 13-20, who love to sing and share their musical gifts as a worshipful expression of their faith.

**Floral Ministry**

This ministry ensures that the church and its grounds maintain an appealing and inviting atmosphere with fresh flowers and floral arrangements. This ministry also supports other special church events when necessary.

**Follow-Up Ministry**

This ministry is responsible for maintaining communication with guests after their visit to the church as a way of ensuring they felt welcomed as well as staying connected with our college students and military members.

**Greeters Ministry**

The purpose of the Greeters Ministry is to extend warm hospitality to each person entering the Church with a gracious heart, warm smile, kind words and a handshake as they enter and exit the church building.

**Health and Human Services Ministry**

This ministry exists to raise awareness of the ongoing health concerns and disparities, as well as confront the issues of injustice that negatively affect the church and its surrounding communities.

**Hospitality Ministry**

This ministry is responsible for providing culinary support to the church's main events throughout the year. They train volunteers in the proper use of kitchen, which include materials, food sanitation, cleanliness, health department issues, etc.).

**Marketplace Ministry**

The Marketplace Ministry provides business owners on information on remaining ahead of trends as they compete in the marketplace. It also provides an opportunity to advertise and market their respective business to the church and the public at large.

**Men's Ministry**

The Men's Ministry provides opportunities for men to grow in their spiritual relationship and knowledge of God, to be strengthened as disciples of the Christian faith, and

**Childrens Church Ministry** is dedicated to the biblical education and worship experiences of our youngest treasures through lessons and activities that are conducive to the age of each child.

**Scholarship Ministry** ensures that our youth have a contributing means for continuing their education. It provides financial assistance to enhance the ability of students to achieve their academic goals and develop skills needed for the future.

**Vacation Bible School** provides biblical instruction in a fun environment during summertime.

#### **Evangelism Ministry**

This ministry takes God's Word into the community by proclaiming the gospel and salvation of Jesus Christ, both within and outside the church, and training others on how to effectively share their faith, so that those who are lost will be found and those who are saved will be encouraged to do greater works. This ministry works hand-in-hand with the other missions-related ministries to answer God's call to reach and touch the lives of people throughout the world.

**Home Missions Ministry** provides support for bereaved families, local food banks, soup kitchens and seniors on special days and occasions.

**Foreign Missions Ministry** provides support for missionaries serving abroad which include our sister church, the Grace Temple Baptist Church of the Philippines.

**Prison Ministry** focuses on the transitioning of persons from incarceration into society. at Grace Temple, this ministry serves to evangelize and assist those who are incarcerated or involved in reentry programs.

**Community Outreach Ministry** puts God's Word into action while serving those who may be homeless, disadvantaged or in need. It is dedicated to serving the "least of these" as mentioned in Matthew 25.

**Deacons Ministry**

This ministry comprises both men and women who are ordained to serve through tending to the needs of members while promoting spiritual harmony. They are responsible for caring for the physical needs of the congregation so the Pastor can concentrate on the spiritual and give oversight to the Benevolence Ministry.

**Benevolence Ministry** an extension of the Deacon's Ministry and is responsible for the consideration of emergency financial support to individuals or families in times of crisis and personal hardship.

**College and Career Ministry**

This ministry provides a forum for members from age 18-35 who gather for dialogue and fellowship throughout the year to discuss contemporary and relevant topics that strengthen, encourage, and build each other up in the faith through the study of God's Word and fellowship with others.

**Community Development Corporation (CDC)**

The Grace Temple CDC is an independent 501(c)3 organization meeting the faith based needs of a growing community. It exists to enhance, empower, build, and improve the social, educational, and quality of life for people in the community surrounding the Grace Temple Baptist Church and beyond.

**Department of Christian Education**

This department oversees the Church's teaching ministries to ensure instruction supports God's Word and doctrine and is responsible for training and certifying teachers across many disciplines. This ministry gives oversight for Sunday School, Bible Studies, Vacation Bible School, and New Members Classes.

**Sunday School** offers biblical instruction to people as they move from membership to discipleship. It is responsible to teach God's Word to all ages, using various theological methods.

*The Associate Pastors and Ministers assist the Pastor in various leadership roles, which include leading ministries, teaching, and New Members' classes. They also serve as worship leaders and preachers when required.*

*The Stewards Ministry direct the legal and financial affairs of the Church. They maintain responsibility for ensuring the church operates in a safe, secure and compliant manner, as well as, handling the accounting of tithes and offerings, property purchases and upkeep, and managing ministry budgets.*

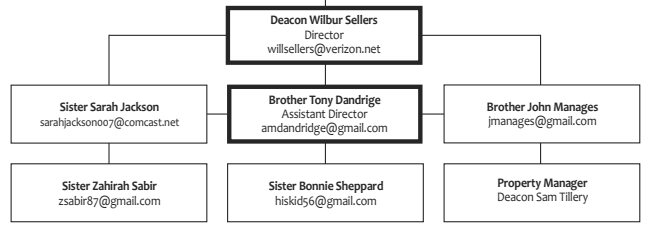
*The Elders Council is made up of administrative and pastoral representatives from the active membership. They are responsible for the spiritual, financial, physical and overall welfare of the Church and its ministries.*

*The Deacons Ministry comprises both men and women who are ordained to serve by caring for the physical needs of the congregation so the Pastor can concentrate on the spiritual. They also give oversight to the Benevolence Ministry.*

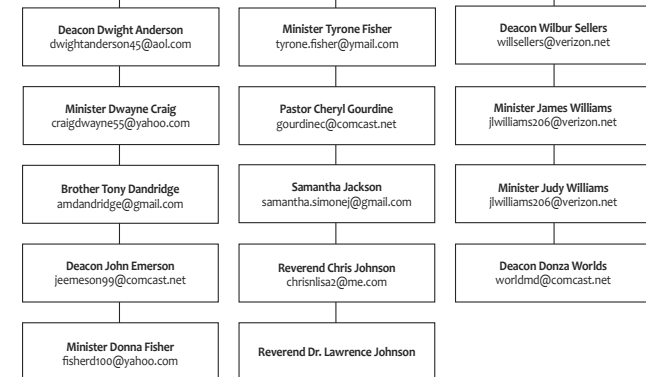
*The Ministry Shepherds are responsible for the supervision of ministry leaders and are accountable for the continued effectiveness of church ministries.*



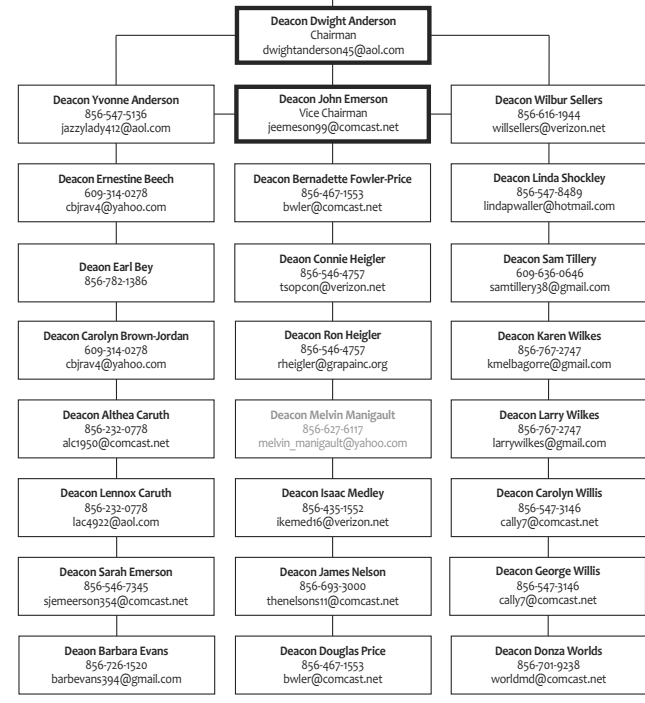
