The end of it shall be with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined. 27 Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but in the middle of the week he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. and on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, Even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate."

What the Bible says about Day-for-a-Year- Principle

Numbers 14:34

According to the number of the days in which you spied out the land, forty days, for each day you shall bear your guilt one year, namely forty years, and you shall know My rejection.

Ezekiel 4:4-6

"Lie also on your left side, and lay the iniquity of the house of Israel upon it. According to the number of the days that you lie on it, you shall bear their iniquity. 5 For I have laid on you the years of their iniquity, according to the number of the days, three hundred and ninety days; so, you shall bear the iniquity of the house of Israel. 6 And when you have completed them, lie again on your right side; then you shall bear the iniquity of the house of Judah forty days. I have laid on you a day for each year.

538 BC + 483 years = 55 BC. No significant biblical event.

520 BC + 483 years = 37 BC. No significant biblical event.

457 BC + 483 years = AD 27. Jesus is baptized and begins His ministry.

444 BC + 483 years = AD 40. No significant biblical event.

Christ's ministry ended in AD 31, the year of His crucifixion and resurrection.

Creation Pattern.

6000 Years of Man's rule.

King Solomon (a type of Jesus) had 6 steps to this throne and the 7th step was his throne

2 Chronicles 9:18

The throne had six steps, with a footstool of gold, which were fastened to the throne; there were [a]armrests on either side of the place of the seat, and two lions stood beside the armrests.

Lazarus (a type of Israel) was sick and dead for a total of 6 days

John 11:1; 5-6; 14; 39

1 Now a certain man was sick, Lazarus of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha. 2 It was that Mary who anointed the Lord with fragrant oil and wiped His feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick. 3 Therefore the sisters sent to Him, saying, "Lord, behold, he whom You love is sick."

5 Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. 6 So, when He heard that he was sick, He stayed two more days in the place where He was. 7 Then after this He said to the disciples, "Let us go to Judea again."

14 Then Jesus said to them plainly, "Lazarus is dead.

39 Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of him who was dead, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there is a stench, for he has been dead four days."

Jesus resurrected him on the 7th day

John 11:40-44

Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?" 41 Then they took away the stone [d]from the place where the dead man was lying. And Jesus lifted up His eyes and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me. 42 And I know that You always hear Me, but because of the people who are standing by I said this, that they may believe that You sent Me." 43 Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!" 44 And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Loose him, and let him go."

After 6 days, Jesus took his closest disciples up into a high mountain and was transfigured (a picture of the Second Advent) before them

Matthew 17:1

Now after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, led them up on a high mountain by themselves;

Mark 9:2

Now after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up on a high mountain apart by themselves; and He was transfigured before them.

After 6 days, Moses was called up to mount Sinai to be in the presence of God in the midst of the cloud

Exodus 24:16

Now the glory of the Lord rested on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days. And on the seventh day He called to Moses out of the midst of the cloud.

Noah was 600 years of age when God destroyed the world with the flood

Genesis 7:6

Noah was six hundred years old when the floodwaters were on the earth.

And the ark rested in the 7th month

Genesis 8:4

Then the ark rested in the seventh month, the seventeenth day of the month, on the mountains of Ararat.

King Joash was the rightful king of Israel but who was hidden in the temple of God for 6 years while an impostor reigned (Queen Athaliah - a picture of Satan the devil, the great usurper). At the beginning of the 7th year, the king was brought forth to sit on his rightful throne, and the usurper was put to death (2 Kings 11:16).

Slaves worked for 6 years and the 7th year was freedom

Exodus 21:2

If you buy a Hebrew servant, he shall serve six years; and in the seventh he shall go out free and pay nothing.

Deuteronomy 15:1

At the end of every seven years you shall grant a [a]release of debts.

4000 years Old Testament

"Life" shows up after the 4th day in the creation narrative. Likewise, Christ shows up after 4,000 years and brings "life"

John 1:1-5

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. 5 And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

John 10:10

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

John 3:16

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

The Passover lamb was set aside 4 days before it was sacrificed

Exodus 12:3

Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: 'On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household.

Exodus 12:6

Now you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month. Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at twilight.

This of course is a type and shadow that pointed to Jesus, the Lamb of God, who was to come and die for the salvation of mankind. The Lamb of God was sacrificed from the foundation of the world (Revelation 13:8) and was killed at Passover 4,000 years later.

2000 years Church Age

Jesus stayed with the Samaritan woman (a type of the Church) for 2 days

John 4:40

So when the Samaritans had come to Him, they urged Him to stay with them; and He stayed there two days.

The Good Samaritan (a type of Jesus) gave the innkeeper 2 pence (equal to 2 day's wages) to care for the wounded man, promising to return and settle the account

Luke 10:35

On the next day, when he departed, he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said to him, 'Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I come again, I will repay you.'

During the 6 days before going to the wedding feast in Cana, Jesus took a trip on the 4th day and was not seen again until the 7th day

John 1:19

Now this is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who are you?"

John 1:29

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! 30 This is He of whom I said, 'After me comes a Man who [k]is preferred before me, for He was before me.' 31 I did not know Him; but that He should be revealed to Israel, therefore I came baptizing with water."

John 1:35

Again, the next day, John stood with two of his disciples.

John 1:43

The following day Jesus wanted to go to Galilee, and He found Philip and said to him, "Follow Me."

John 2:1

On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there.

Abomination of Desolation

The Symbols

Lampstands: the seven churches.

Revelation 1:12

Then I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands,

Revelation 1:20

The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands which you saw are <u>the seven churches</u>.

Stars: Represents Angels

Revelation 1:16

He had in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword, and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength.

Revelation 1:20

The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: <u>The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches</u>, and the seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches.

Stars: Represents Fallen Angels

Revelation 12:4

His tail drew a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was ready to give birth, to devour her Child as soon as it was born.

Isaiah 14:12-15

"How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, you who weakened the nations! 13 For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation on the farthest sides of the north; 14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.' 15 Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, to the lowest depths of the Pit.

Two-Edged Sword: Represents the Word of God

Revelation 1:16

He had in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth went a <u>sharp two-edged</u> <u>sword</u>, and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength.

Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God is living and powerful, and <u>sharper than any two-edged</u> <u>sword</u>, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Crystal Sea: Biblical rule of interpretation governing the use of the word sea = a great mass of people;

Crystal = flawless, having right standing with God, i.e. the Church and the Old Testament Saints.

chiefly literally, e.g., "the Red Sea," Act 7:36; 1Cr 10:1; Hbr 11:29;

metaphorically, of "the ungodly men" described in Jud 1:13 (cp. Isa 57:20);

symbolically, in the apocalyptic vision of "a glassy sea like unto crystal," Rev 4:6, emblematic of the fixed purity and holiness of all that appertains to the authority and judicial dealings of God

Revelation 4:6

Before the throne there was a sea of glass, like crystal. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back.

Revelation 15:2

And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God.

Mountain of Fire: Represents Fiery Meteorite.

Revelation 8:8

Then the second angel sounded: And something like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood.

Revelation 8:10-11

Then the third angel sounded: And a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water. The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the water, because it was made bitter.

Amos 7:4

Thus, the Lord God showed me: Behold, the Lord God called for conflict by fire, and it consumed the great deep and devoured the territory.

Jeremiah 51:25

"Behold, I am against you, O destroying mountain, Who destroys all the earth," says the Lord. "And I will stretch out My hand against you, roll you down from the rocks, and make you a burnt mountain.

Lamp Stands and Olive Trees: denotes carriers of light, with longevity and fruitfulness.

Revelation 1:12

Then I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands,

Revelation 11:4

These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands standing before the God of the earth.

The Women of Revelation 12: Represent Israel; While the Male Child is Jesus

Revelation 12:1-2

Now a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a garland of twelve stars. 2 Then being with child, she cried out in labor and in pain to give birth.

The Wilderness: Represents an Earthly Hiding Place, Populated, and With Sufficient Resources to Accommodate the Jewish Remnant.

Revelation 12:6-14

Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days. 7 And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God, day and night, has been cast down. 11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and

they did not love their lives to the death. 12 Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time." 13 Now when the dragon saw that he had been cast to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male Child. 14 But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she is nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent.

The Water: Represents the Anti-Christ as a Powerful Orator Releasing a Flood of Words.

Revelation 12:15-16

So, the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood. 16 But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the flood which the dragon had spewed out of his mouth.

Isaiah 59:19

So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun; when the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him.

The Beast: Represents the System Satan Hope Will Succeed and Give Him Control of the Earth; Empires and Nations; Also Identifies the Anti-Christ and the False Prophet.

Revelation 13:1

Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name.

Sickle: Represents an Instrument of Harvest

Revelation 14:14-17

Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and on the cloud sat One like the Son of Man, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a sharp sickle. 15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, "Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the time has come for You to reap,

for the harvest of the earth is ripe." 16 So He who sat on the cloud thrust in His sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped. 17 Then another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle.

Winepress: Represents Armageddon

Revelation 14:17-20

Then another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. 18 And another angel came out from the altar, who had power over fire, and he cried with a loud cry to him who had the sharp sickle, saying, "Thrust in your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe." 19 So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. 20 And the winepress was trampled outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress, up to the horses' bridles, for one thousand six hundred furlongs.

Great Harlot: Represents All the World's Religions – She Has Great Influence Over the Multitudes Through Sorceries (Witchcraft and Drugs)

Revelation 17:1-2

Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and talked with me, saying to me, "Come, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot who sits on many waters, 2 with whom the kings of the earth committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth were made drunk with the wine of her fornication."

Babylon: Represents a worldly system Religion, Commerce and Government.

Revelation 14:8

And another angel followed, saying, "Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication."

Sword of the Spirit: Represents the Word of God.

Revelation 19:15

Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Revelation 19:21

And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

Ephesians 6:17

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;

Zechariah 14:12

And this shall be the plague with which the Lord will strike all the people who fought against Jerusalem: Their flesh shall dissolve while they stand on their feet, Their eyes shall dissolve in their sockets, and their tongues shall dissolve in their mouths.

Bottomless Pit: Represents the Abyss or Abode of Fallen Angels.

Revelation 20:1-3

Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. 2 He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; 3 and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while.

Thrones: Represents Those Saints Who Return to the Earth to Reign

Revelation 20:4

And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

Gog and Magog: Represents the identity of those who choose to follow Satan after his release from the bottomless pit.

Revelation 20:8

And will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea.

Not to be confused with Gog and Magog of Ezekial 37-38

The Bride: Represents the Lambs wife; the New Jerusalem.

Revelation 21:9

Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife."

Dogs: Represents evil Doers

Revelation 22:15

But outside are dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie.

Philippians 3:2

Beware of dogs, beware of evil workers, beware of the mutilation!

Galatians 5:15

But if you bite and devour one another, beware lest you be consumed by one another!

The Four Horseman:

White Horse Rider: Antichrist

Revelation 6:1-2

Now I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals; and I heard one of the four living creatures saying with a voice like thunder, "Come and see." 2 And I looked, and behold, a white horse. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.

Red Horse Rider: Man of War

Revelation 6:3-4

When He opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come and see." 4 Another horse, fiery red, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth, and that people should kill one another; and there was given to him a great sword.

Black Horse Rider: Effects Food Supply

Revelation 6:5-6

When He opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, "Come and see." So I looked, and behold, a black horse, and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. 6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine."

Pale Horse Rider: Death and Hell

Revelation 6:7-8

When He opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, "Come and see." 8 So I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him. And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death, and by the beasts of the earth.

Note: Horsemen ride throughout the seven years of tribulation.

Note: They effect only ¼ of the earth during the seven-year period.

Revelation 6:8

So, I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him. And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death, and by the beasts of the earth.

Note: The horsemen are restricted both by angelic opposition and their on internal problems. Never are they permitted to reach their full capacity of their destructive potential.

The Unknowns of Revelation!

The unknowns are not explained anywhere within scriptural context therefore, understanding is withheld until our knowledge is complete. When we see Jesus, we will be like Him.

The personal identity of the white horse' rider.

Revelation 6:1-2

The reason for the half hour of silence.

(This verse clearly shows us the divisions of Revelation.

Revelation 1 covers the things you have seen, the vision of Jesus.

Revelation 2-3 covers the things which are, the church age.

Revelation 4-22 covers the things which are to come, the time subsequent to the church age.

As we move forward, keep these three divisions in perspective, because chapter1 supplies us with the keys to the entire book, it is the most important chapter of Revelation.

Although chapters 4-22 cover the future, they will also include both Old and New Testament events of the past. The Holy Spirit definitely ties the future to the past record of both God's plan and action.)
