- Written by a Jewish Tax-collector named Levi (Matt. 9:9-13)
- Bridge between the Old and New Testament
- Therefore there are 53 quotations & 76 References from the Old
- Levi refers to 25 of the 29 books of the Old Testament
- Most often word is FULFILLED 1:22, 2:15, 2:17...etc.
- Christ is spoken of as the Son of David
- Is the Kingdom Gospel....
- Is not chronological as is Mark and Luke...
- Inspired to present Christ as king reveled & rejects by Israel
- Shows how Jesus turned to the Gentiles
- Shows Him rejected, crucified, buried, risen again!
- Reveals the final authority Jesus is given in Matt. 28:18-20

II. The Fulfilled _____(18 -25)

Promise goes way back to Gen. 3:15

"I will put enmity between thee and the woman, between thy seed and her seed...it shall bruise thy head and you shall bruise His heal".

- Notice the word "Fulfilled" God always keeps His Word!
- Joseph believed the dream...Had faith in God, protected Mary
- Jesus means "Joshua" or "Saviour" (Greek version)

Two Joshua's in the Old Testament – One a conqueror (Book of Joshua)

The other a High priest (Zech. 2)

Isaiah picks up the promise in Isaiah 7:14 "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign, The Virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel."

Practical lessons from Matthew 1:

- 1. God is in control of history
- 2. Grace of God makes salvation possible to everyone
- 3. Joseph pondered these things..don't make quick decisions
- 4. When God commands immediate obedience!

Introduction: We come again to the moment in history that changes everything! "In the fullness of time, God sent for His son, born of a woman, born under the law." God chose at this moment to manifest heaven to earth and the "Kingdom of God" visited earth through a simple girl from Bethlehem. She birthed God's kingdom on earth...we are called to do the same! We birth in our spirit by the Holy Spirit and it becomes visible by faith! Mary had no idea how this plan worked, but trusted God with a pure heart. She left the rest up to God's power and purpose.

Jesus introduces a new Kingdom

Introduction: The early chapters of Matthew are transitional between the Old and New Testaments. John the Baptist was the last of the old testament prophets, Jesus was the beginning of the new. John preached "Repent and be baptized" Jesus preached, "The kingdom of God is at hand". As Jesus introduces the kingdom of God in a new dimension, we see the foundation being laid for the entire new testament. Paul concluded the book of Acts still preaching the same gospel Jesus preached. "Then Paul dwelt two whole years in his own rented house, and received all who came to him, preaching the kingdom of God and teaching the things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ with all confidence, no one forbidding him." Acts 28:30-31 Paul received the revelation of God's grace, but never ceased centering his message on the "kingdom of God".

- A. What is the gospel of the kingdom? **Understanding His Authority!**
 - His ownership over all things (by creation & redemption)
 - His dominion over all things "He is before all things, and in Him all things subsist." Colossians 1:17
 - His authority over sin, sickness, Satan, poverty and all the kingdoms of this world.
- B. What are we to preach to the nations?

Acts 9:17:

"All power is given unto men in heaven and earth... go ye therefore."

- Jesus gave them authority to cast out demons, heal the sick....
- Jesus said, "I will be with you...." Matthew 28:20

III. Jesus introduces a new kind of baptism... ______ (Imparting His power and authority to YOU and ME)

What happens at this baptism?

- It is separate from being "Indwelt by the Holy Spirit" (sealed) Eph. 1

- It imparts to you His fullness in you and upon you for ministry.

- It is primarily for witness and authority to take the gospel to the nations.

Have you received this baptism since you believed?

Ask by faith, just like you received Christ.... Open your heart and mouth to speak forth His words.... Ask Him to fill you to overflowing. Wait and believe you have received.

PATHWAY TO HAPPINESS (blessed)

Introduction: The King, Jesus, has now been introduced. In chapter 1 of Matthew we saw the providence of God, "In the fullness of time" and the promise of God Gen. 3:15. In Chapter 2 was seen the entrance of the kingdom in a world of another king Herod. How God invades the darkness with the presence of Christ. In Chapter 3 we saw the introduction of the King at His baptism and the entrance of Jesus new baptism of the Holy Spirit and fire. Jesus is tested in the wilderness in chapter 4 and comes out into His full anointing. "Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit".

Now Jesus teaches on the principles of the kingdom. What do kingdom people look like. What are the attitudes that true kingdom people demonstrate through the righteousness of Christ.

I. Jesus gives teaching concerning right Relationship.

MATTHEW 5:17-20

Our relationship depends totally on the righteousness of Christ!

1. _______righteousness. Deposited to our account through the finished Work of Christ. "And be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith." Philippians 3:9

2. ______righteousness. "Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me." Philippians 3:12

(i.e living in the full provision of His grace)

"That the eyes of your understanding may be enlightened...." Eph. 1

This righteousness is lived out by the power of the Holy Spirit as we embrace the "Mind of Christ" by faith.

II. Jesus gives teaching concerning right witness.

MATTHEW 5:13-16

- 1. We are the "salt of the earth", flavored by the righteousness of Christ in us and through us.
- 2. We are the "light of the world". His light shines through us.
 Jesus great prayer for us in

 John 17:22-23 "And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that
 they may be one just as We are one: I in them, and You in Me; that they

may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me."

III. Jesus gives teaching concerning right character.

MATTHEW 5:1-10

The beatitudes are the characters traits of the nature of Christ's righteousness dwelling in us. This is how a child of the kingdom will look when we walk in the Spirit.

- 1. "Blessed are the poor_____ for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."
 - Our attitude toward **OURSELVES**. We must be empty before we can be filled. *Jesus emptied Himself of His divine rights!*

Philippians 2:5-6 "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who being in the form of God thought it not robbery to be equal with God, but made himself of no reputation, but took upon himself the form of a servant and was made in the likeness of men."

- 2. "Blessed are those who for they shall be comforted.
 - Our attitude toward SIN. We should mourn over the consequences of sin both in our lives and others.
 Jesus wept over Jerusalem.

Sin...when it is finished brings death....

James 1:14-16 "But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. ¹⁵ Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death."

- "Adam and Eve looked upon the fruit, took it and they died."
- "Achan looked on the garment, took it, and he and his family died"
- "David looked upon the woman, took her, and his son died."

All sin must be paid for with death.......

- 3. "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth."
 - Our attitude toward **OTHERS**. Meekness is power under control. Coming under the ruler ship of Christ.

Jesus said, "Not my will by Thine be done."

"Submitting one to another in the fear of the Lord"

CHAPTER 6 THE SPIRIT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

(His righteousness revealed)

The key verse for all of Matthew is found in Chapter 6:33 "Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you."

True righteousness is revealed in our heart attitude in three ways

- 1. Believer and his worship in prayer and fasting
- 2. Believer and his wealth in trust and faith
- 3. Believer and his walk in peace and rest

Your prayer life is a revelation of your passion for His life, power and kingdom. How are we to pray?

- 1. Praying Always Staying in a constant attitude of prayer
 Ephesians 6:18 "praying always with all prayer and supplication in the
 Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and
 supplication for all the saints"
- 2. **Praying in the Spirit** Tuning your heart in to the things of the Spirit Jude 1:20 "But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit."
- 3. Pray in Faith Without faith it is impossible to please God,. Mark 11:24 "Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them."

Jesus gave us this awesome prayer called the "**Lord's Prayer**". It is really a revelation of His heart for the kingdom to be revealed on earth.

Jesus said pray in this manner......Matthew 6:10-13

- "Our Father, which art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name, Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever and ever, Amen."


God has placed in the desire of all men to return to Eden. A place of peace, harmony, safety, love and goodness. It is only found in the Righteousness of Christ.

- 3. Release the kingdom by faith! Understand it is of Grace!

Knowing and doing the will of God on earth creates a divine connection between heaven and earth. It releases heaven to earth...

Jesus revealed that this was His Highest Purpose:

John 7:17 "If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself."

John 6:38 "For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me"

John 5:30 "I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me."

What are the keys to doing the will of God "on earth"?

- 1. Submitting your body as a living sacrifice. Romans 12:1-2 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God."
- 2. Renewing you mind daily to God's word & to hear His voice.
- 3. What are the three voices we hear daily?
 - Inner voice of man Called "Self-speak"
 - **Voices of demons** (Satan spoke to Eve, Satan spoke to Jesus)
 - Voice of God "And God said..." over and over again in the word.

Remember the power of listening to God. Part of your prayer time should be to Listen. (5-fold prayer called the Two Hands prayer)

One hand:

1. Worship 2. Confession 3. Intercession 4. Listening 5. Thanksgiving

Other hand:

2. Intercession: 1. World. 2. Ministries 3. Authorities 4. Family 5. Poor & weak

What should our attitude be about wealth and riches and money?

- 1. Money has potential to be showy? You can easily parade your money, or use you money to influence others or even control. Give quietly and graciously.

 Matthew 6:1-3
- 2. Money has potential to control you and cause you to be double minded. Your heart can become dark with ulterior motives. Matthew 6;21 24 There is a reason Jesus called it "Filthy Lucre" "Ungodly Mammon"
 - 3. Money can be a blessing in the kingdom. But we must:
 - Give to direct and guard our hearts. "Where you treasure is, there will your heart be also." V-21
 - "Seek first the kingdom and His righteousness and all these things will be added unto you." Matthew 6:33

Giving therefore becomes one of the greatest evidences of personal freedom from greed and bondage to money.
