WHAT IS THE TRUE GOSPEL?

Paul clearly defines the revelation Jesus Christ gave him of the true gospel. Legalists and Judiazers were constantly trying to undermine Paul's revelation with a call to return to the law. The first two chapters of Galatians are personal as Paul tells how he received directly from Jesus Christ Himself the true gospel. The word "Gospel" is found 45 times in these two chapters. Paul did not preach some second-hand gospel that he learned from Peter or Jerusalem. That is why God kept Paul and Peter apart lest the simple, powerful message of grace become confused with law.

ISRAEL AND THE NEW TESTAMENT CHURCH

The Book of Acts is pivotal in understanding God's kingdom economy and transition from Israel to the revelation of the church. It moves from Peter's ministry in Jerusalem with the Jewish believers (Chapters 1 - 12) to Paul's ministry in Antioch (Chapters 13 - 28) now including Gentiles along with Jews. The whole concept of the Kingdom of God is expanded to include Jews and Gentiles into one great body...the church. **It is not replacement theology but completion theology.** God's ultimate plan is to embrace all the world bringing all believer's, Jews and Gentiles, into the beautiful "bride" of Christ. Paul reflected this and clearly taught that the kingdom of God continued to be taught to the Gentiles not just the Jews. This is found in the very last verse of Acts **"And Paul continued in Caesar's household to teach the kingdom of God and concerning the Lord Jesus Christ"**. The book of Acts takes us on the journey of the transition of the gospel from the Jews to the Gentiles...the center of God's movement from Jerusalem to Antioch and from Peter's ministry to Paul's. Listen through this exciting book to see how God moved in the early church and how He is moving today.

Jude is the half brother of Christ called "Judas" in Mark 6:3. He saw the resurrected Christ along with James and became a believer at the same time. They are both mentioned in Acts 1:14 in the upper room at Pentecost. He calls himself a "Bondservant of Christ" not the brother of Christ. He emphasizes the "keeping power" of Christ amidst warnings of false teachers among the church. I Peter said they were coming, Jude now says they were there. This puts this letter later than I Peter, probably two years later.

Paul had never visited Colosse. During his three years of ministry in Ephesus "all Asia" heard the Gospel. One of Paul's converts in Ephesus was a man named Epaphras whose home was in Colosse. Epaphras took the message back home and started the church... perhaps in the home of Philemon who lived in Colosse with one of his slaves, Onesimus. Epaphras visited Paul in prison in Rome telling him of a new heresy called "Gnosticism" from the Greek word... "to know". They professed to have superior knowledge of spiritual things. It was a strange combination of Greek philosophy and Jewish legalism. Paul clearly lays out the truth of the pre-eminence of Christ in all knowledge and wisdom. This book will inspire you to realize that the simplicity of Christ is superior to all human understanding.

When Timothy joined Paul at Athens, Paul promptly sent him to Thessalonica to encourage the new church. Timothy then reported to Paul the state of the new church. It was in Corinth, about the year 50, that Paul wrote I Thessalonians. II Thessalonians was written just a few months later. The Second Coming of Christ is mentioned at the end of each chapter and is the overwhelming theme of this great book. Paul was also showing us how new churches can prosper, grow and be spiritually led.

The Book of Acts closes with Paul a prisoner in Rome. The latter years of Paul are largely agreed upon by most scholars. Paul was acquitted before Caesar and forced to leave Rome after two years of imprisonment. This would be about the Spring of 62 AD. With Luke and Timothy, he visited Ephesus where he discovered that his prophecy about the "wolves" had been fulfilled, because the church at Ephesus had been invaded by false teachers. His warnings in I Timothy suggest that this false teachings were similar to the Gnosticism he had attacked at Colosse. Paul ministered there himself for a short time, then left to go to Philippi. He left Timothy behind as his special assistant to oversee the church and get rid of all the false teachers. Their parting was a sorrowful one according to II Timothy 1:4

Paul was arrested again, after his brief season of freedom.. We have no details as to his travels at this time. Titus indicates that he visited Necropolis. He must have departed from there and gone to Troas, where, in a "quick exit" he had left his cloak, books, and parchments, with his host (II Timothy 4:13) Carpus. How or where he was arrested again, we do not know. We do know that Nero had unleashed a terrible persecution against the Christians, and that Paul's situation in this second imprisonment was far different from his first. He was now a hated prisoner, in a Roman prison, and not an accused man awaiting trial in "his own house". As we read this final letter from Paul's heart, we can sense his loneliness and heartache as he faced his trial and certain martyrdom. "Only Luke is with me" he writes, and he begs his son in the faith, Timothy, to come to him as quickly as possible.
