## **1 P**ETER

Hope & Suffering "Responding to Suffering, Part 3: Press to Spiritual Maturity"

**INTRO:** As we are learning, a Biblical response to trials and suffering is not so much about ADDING something to what we are already doing, but letting go of what is expendable and **doubling-down** on the essentials of our faith. Today, we learn a third God-honoring response to suffering.

## I. **Because Believers and their spiritual inheritance** are eternally secure, we can *each* pursue \_\_\_\_\_
