## **1 P**ETER

Hope & Suffering "Worry and the Persecuted Church"

**INTRO:** In this final section, Peter addressed the Church in her united stance against persecution. She must stay focused and faithful without worry or else risk spiritual damage.

I. The Church will suffer \_\_\_\_\_. God sovereignly allows persecution to refine us and set us on the divine path to glory.
