## Defining *Success* in Christian Ministry

**INTRO:** Whether he intended to defend himself against slander or else to provide an example for church leadership in Thessalonica, Paul provides us with three principles for successful Christian ministry.

(2:1-4).
Paul's boldness came from his form belief in the truth of the Gospel with which he felt entrusted by God.
Successful ministry(2:5-8).
Why we do something is every bit as important as what we do. Paul predetermined not to adopt worldly standards for success in ministry
predetermined not to ddopt wortdry standards for success in ministry

**FINAL NOTE: Results** are not part of our definition for success because results are *God's responsibility*, who alone is worthy to receive praise! (2:13).
