

# 1 & 2 SAMUEL

## LEGENDARY

### *“The Davidic Covenant and the Grateful Believer”*

**INTRO:** *With a new palace in Jerusalem and peace characterizing his kingdom, David had time to contemplate a permanent abode for the ark, the symbol of God’s presence. But did God have something better for David?*

**I. David’s Monarchy was \_\_\_\_\_ of Messiah’s future Kingdom.** *David’s Monarchy was a picture of what the world could expect in the future (Cf. 2 Samuel 5:6-6:23).*

**II. While David’s \_\_\_\_\_ could not guarantee a \_\_\_\_\_, God’s \_\_\_\_\_ would! (7:1-17).**  
*The Davidic Covenant (a sacred contract) promised that a descendant of David would reign on Israel’s throne in fulfilment of all that God promised Israel. Some elements of this prophecy were immediate in fulfilment; others awaited a distant future fulfilment.*

**III. Celebrate God’s \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_ displayed in the Davidic \_\_\_\_\_ (7:18-29).**  
*David’s response to God’s blessings is a model for all Believers.*

**A. God’s \_\_\_\_\_ is every Believers \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*We are nothing apart from God (7:21)*

**B. God’s \_\_\_\_\_ is every Believer’s \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*It’s not about me; it’s about Him! (7:23).*

**C. God’s \_\_\_\_\_ is every Believer’s \_\_\_\_\_.**  
*Faith embraces God’s promises (7:25).*
