The Messiah's Resurrection in Hosea?

Did God's Prophet Foretell of Jesus' Resurrection?

INTRO: Because it is Resurrection Sunday (Easter), we pause in our study of Hosea to focus specifically on a passage from that book that appears to speak of Messiah's resurrection. Does Hosea actually prophesy about the Messiah's (Jesus) resurrection?

I. Jesus claimed that the entire Old Testament spoke

of ______**as** _____. *This claim was made by Jesus to two of His disciples on the Emmaus Road after His resurrection* (Luke 24:13-27; Cf. John 5:39).

II. There are many Old Testament prophecies of the Messiah's ______, ____, and ______, but not as many of His _______, Micah 5:2; Isa. 53:4-6, 10; 61:1; Psalm 16:10; 22:15-21; 1 Cor. 15:1-4.

III. Hosea presented an *overlooked* ______ to Messiah's ______ in his prophecy about

(Hosea 6:2). *The case for its allusion is two-fold.*

A.

Hosea's numbers functioned **rhetorically** for Israel's prophecy but functioned **conventionally** as Messianic prophecy.

B.

Israel was called God's firstborn **son** (Exo. 4:22) but proved disobedient. Jesus is called God's unique Son (John 3:16) who perfectly obeyed the Father.
