*Covenant Renewal* Becoming the Leader God is Pleased to Use

**INTRO:** Sixty (60) years have passed since the events of chapter 6. As we start chapter 7, readers **finally** get introduced to the man whose name is attached to this book. But who is Ezra and why is God pleased to use him in leadership? Would God be pleased to use us?
