## **Genesis 1-11**

### *Lessons from the Flood:*

#### *Lesson 1: "Privileged Revelation; Passionate Responsibility"*

**INTRO:** *Genesis 6-9 relates one of the most beloved stories in our Bible. Though a single account, there are several important lessons that may be gleaned. Today is Part 1 of a three-part series.*

### **I. God privileges Believers with revelation of His**

\_\_\_\_\_ **(6:9-13).** *Just as God revealed His plans to judge the world to righteous Noah, so God has revealed His plans to judge the world again to righteous NT Believers (Cf. 2 Peter 3:10).*

### **II. The "\_\_\_\_\_" of our \_\_\_\_\_ as privileged recipients of God's \_\_\_\_\_ of judgment may cause us to shirk it (6:14-21).** *The world considers anything it doesn't understand as "folly." Noah's "folly" was the Ark. The Believer's folly is the cross (Cf. 1 Corinthians 1:18-25; 4:10).*

### **III. To demonstrate our belief in a coming \_\_\_\_\_ obediently \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ (6:22).**

*Like Noah, we must obediently warn people of God's future judgment for sin and offer His forgiveness through Jesus (Cf. 2 Peter 2:5).*

**A.** Warn of God's \_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_.  
*Before anyone can receive the **good** news, they must appreciate the **bad** news. Sin places mankind under divine judgment.*

**B.** Offer God's \_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_.  
*The Gospel is the **good news** that forgiveness of sin is attained in trusting Jesus' atoning sacrifice which satisfied God's wrath.*
