III. Remind God of His promised _____ of _____ by engaging in authentic _____. *As long as there is a worshiping remnant, God's suspension of judgment remains in force. Authentic worship is modeled by Noah.*

A. A clean _____. *As Psalm 24 reminds, sinful behavior or motivation, hinders our intimacy before God.*

B. A clear _____. *Worship can occur anywhere, but congregational worship is a powerful testimony.*

C. A complete _____. *The burnt offering symbolized complete devotion to the Lord. NT Believers bring a sacrifice of praise to the Lord.*
