Everything's Better with Jesus!

"A Better Message, Part 3"

INTRO: What good is it to be proven God's Supreme Messenger if no one follows Your message? We have thus far learned **two** reasons that Jesus' message **MUST** be followed by those professing belief in His Messiahship. Today we will learn a **third** reason.

I. The Son (Jesus) is God's supreme _____ (2:1).

*The author proved the Son's superiority over **prophets** and **angels** (1:1-14), but **why** is His message consequential?*

II. A Supreme _____ means *little* if His message is not _____. The response of accepting Jesus' message is a logical **necessity (Cf. "...we **MUST**..."). **Professing** believers **MUST** be careful to not **drift away**.**

III. Pay close attention to the Son's message because it promises an _____ Savior through His _____ (2:11-18). The author revealed two resulting consequences of Jesus' incarnation.

A. Jesus' Incarnation positioned Him to _____ the Devil of _____ (2:14-16). *The Devil (the slanderer) used the fear of death to "enslave" people.*

B. Jesus' Incarnation promoted Him as our _____ (2:17-18). *God became Man to offer the perfect sacrifice (Himself) and understands the temptations we endure.*
