## *Everything's Better with Jesus!*

### "A Better Message, Part 2"

**INTRO:** *What good is it to be proven God's Supreme Messenger if no one follows Your message? Last week we learned the first, and most important, reason that Jesus' message **MUST** be followed by those professing belief in His Messiahship. Today we will learn a second reason.*

**I. The Son (Jesus) is God's supreme \_\_\_\_\_.**

*The author proved the Son's superiority over **prophets** and **angels** (1:1-14), but why is His message consequential?*

**II. A Supreme \_\_\_\_\_ means *little* if His message is not \_\_\_\_\_ (2:1).**

*The response of accepting Jesus' message is not just logical but imperative (Cf. "...we **MUST**..."). Professing believers **MUST** be careful to not drift away.*

**III. Pay close attention to the Son's message because it reveals the \_\_\_\_\_ plan to restore *earthly* \_\_\_\_\_ (2:5-10).**

**A.** Jesus is the Perfect \_\_\_\_\_, *predestined* to \_\_\_\_\_ over \_\_\_\_\_ (2:5-8). While the **first Adam** failed, the **last Adam** succeeded (Cf. Gen. 1:28; 1 Cor. 15:20-28, 45).

**B.** The \_\_\_\_\_ was the Messiah's *predestined* path to restore \_\_\_\_\_ (2:9-10). His *Incarnation* placed Jesus **temporarily** in a lower state than angels where He suffered death to pay the cost to lift sin's curse (Cf. Isa. 53; 1 Peter 1:18-21).
