*"It's Your Choice..."*

**INTRO:** *Joshua's final farewell address to the nation is best known for his personal commitment to the Lord (24:15). He passionately challenged the nation to do the same. NT Believers should make a similar commitment.*

*How do people see your daily commitment to Jesus?(Cf. Matthew 5:16; Philippians 2:14-15).*
