III. To perfect myopic ______, surrender to Jesus' ______ (8:34-38). Verse 34 defines

surrender and vv35-38 identifies the consequences.

A.

This is turning over control of loves, likes, and life to Jesus!

B.

This means identifying with Jesus, even in His suffering, without which there is no awaiting glory (Cf. Romans 12:1).
