INTRO: Unable to grasp the meaning of Jesus' second passion statement, the disciples argue over greatness. Jesus takes the opportunity to teach them a valuable lesson about how greatness in the Kingdom of God is defined.

(9:49-50). These two perplexing verses connected by a reference to salt which changes in its metaphor from one verse to the other, reveals the ONLY way to serve effectively.
