

## DOES PSALM 91 OFFER A *VACCINE* FOR "COVID-19"?

**INTRO:** *The Psalms were Israel's inspired hymnal. We don't know the tunes to which they were sung, but like any worship song, the words are the most important feature. Some today are citing this psalm as a mantra of personal protection against the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. But is this responsible exegesis? How should NT Believers interpret this Psalm?*

**I. Israel's King was God's \_\_\_\_\_ ("God's Son"), promised divine \_\_\_\_\_ in exchange for personal \_\_\_\_\_ and faithfulness (91:1-16).** *This psalm may have been King David's advice to his successor-son, Solomon.*

**II. Many Christians are claiming that Psalm 91 offers divine \_\_\_\_\_ from the current \_\_\_\_\_.** *But how does one explain the apparent inconsistencies of application?*

**III. Interpret Psalm 91 in the context of the \_\_\_\_\_ Covenant with direct application to the \_\_\_\_\_** *This interpretation removes inconsistencies of other interpretations.*
