The King is Coming! *Jesus Confronts Cold Orthodoxy*

INTRO: *Today we begin the second major section of Revelation with a study of the Glorified Jesus' judgment of His Church. The seven churches represent ALL Churches during the Age between Advents. The first church addressed was the church at Ephesus.*

I. The glorified _____ judges His _____ (2:1).

This judgment is not to condemn but to convict for the purpose of change. His movement among the lampstand shows Jesus' ministry.

II. _____ is good but *heartless* _____

is intolerable (2:2-4). *Orthodoxy is correct doctrine. The absence of love reduces orthodoxy to duty or legalism.*

III. _____ from *heartless* _____ (2:5-7).

*To **repent** is to change one's mind and direction. It begins with **remembering** from where one has fallen. Repentance does two things.*
