† Emmaus Eyes prayer

† Emmaus Gospel prayer

*“We had hoped that he was the one who was going to redeem Israel.” (v. 21)

† To See Jesus prayer

“Open the eyes of my heart, that I might see you in the places where real life hides
you, where my desire for blessing limits you, where my self view blocks my loving
self, where I do not seek all wisdom and knowledge in you.”
Be my reality. Be my blessing. Be my goodness. Be my Master Teacher.”

† Standing Formation prayer

† After Jesus prayer

Jesus...

You have been walking with us

"Emmaus Practice" A 3-step lived rhythm:

1. See *"Jesus, where might you be in this moment?"*
2. Respond *"What would it look like to follow you here?"*
 - turn the cheek
 - tell the truth
 - extend patience
 - give generously
3. Invite *"Who might I walk with in this?"*
