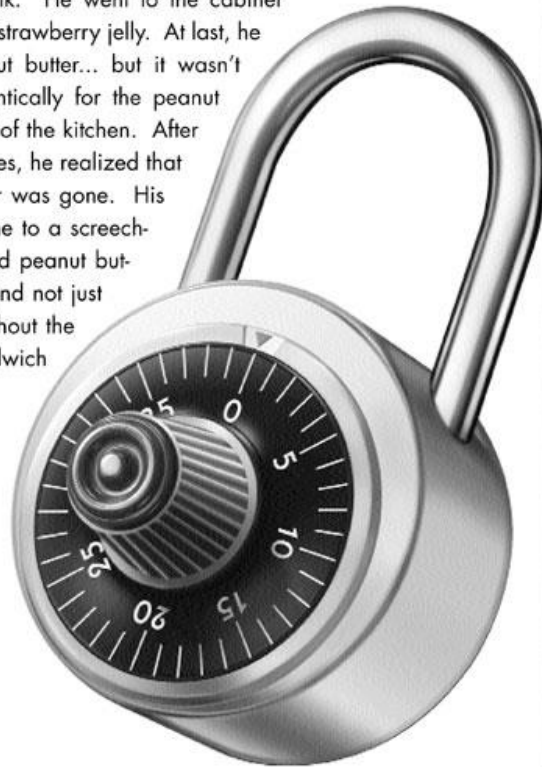

Ephesians 6:1-3 • “Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ‘Honor your father and mother’, which is the first commandment with promise: ‘That it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth’.”

The Apostle Paul emphasized the requirement that children must meet if they desire to have a long and prosperous life. He stated that they had to obey and honor their parents in order to live a blessed life. The scripture does not say that you should only obey your parents, neither does it say that you should only honor your parents. It says that you should obey and honor your parents. In God’s eyes, obedience and honor go together. To obey a parent means to follow his or her command. To honor a parent means to highly esteem him or her and respect him or her. When you obey your parents, you please God. You also show

your parents that you have a desire to please them. It can be very tempting to disobey your parents. In those times of temptation, remember that God will bless you for being obedient. Remember that obedience doesn’t just happen. You must choose to obey on a daily basis.

Since your parents are governing authorities that God has placed in your life, you should always honor them. Your parents are not on your peer level. Therefore, they should always receive the highest level of respect from you. Just as you would honor your favorite celebrity, you should honor your parents in a greater way.

Obedience and honor is the combination that will open up the doors of God’s richest rewards in your life. God will bless your life if you make a sincere effort to obey and honor your parents at all times (even when you don’t feel like it).
