I dislike Daylight Savings Time (DST); it is, to me, part of humanity's rebellion against God. In our folly, we ignore the in- struments He has given us to govern our days (Gen. 1:16) and declare that noon is whenever we want it to be. Yet, I recently realized my own folly in thinking this was just a matter of DST. Our own Central Time Zone stretches from Alabama to Oklahoma, yet the Sun does not reach its zenith at the same time in those two states. Even without DST, our clocks are set subjectively, based on the needs of the railroad industry of the 1800s, instead of objectively on the Sun. Based on this, I have concluded I should stop getting so worked up about DST and accept it if it gets adopted year-round. We will always live with rebellious folly until Christ returns.
