Lifeway Research recently asked pastors what their churches did well. Overwhelmingly, the top success for churches was in corporate worship. Coming in dead last, though highly valued, was discipleship.

Reading about this survey, I couldn't help but wonder what definitions they were using to evaluate themselves. What is their idea of doing corporate worship well? Do they mean it is polished and professional, or Spirit led and Scripture based? What is their idea of "discipleship," are they focused on activities or results? And beyond that, why are these separated?

Corporate worship cannot be separated from discipleship when most people have no other connection with the church than on Sunday mornings. When we join for worship, we model our faith, teach Jesus' commandments, and encourage one another to live in faith. That is discipleship.
