Pastor's Pondering

Early in my discipleship, I was taught the ACTS method of prayer: Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication. You may notice that I basically still follow this pattern in my congregational prayers.

Compare that format with the Lord's Prayer, where Jesus instructs us to ask for our daily bread and then to ask for forgiveness of our sins. In the ACTS terminology, that puts the S before the C.

Through the ACTS method, I was taught that we needed to confess our sins before we brought God our requests. It is as if we can earn God's ear with our confessions.

In contrast, Jesus's pattern would have us ask for provision (bring God our requests) and then seek forgiveness and deliverance. In the Lord's Prayer, we do not earn supplication, but seek His provision as those in need of grace. I like Jesus' way. Now, to see about changing my prayer pattern...
