It has been 25 years since 2,977 people died in the two towers of the World Trade Center, the Pentagon, and a field in Pennsylvania. My general practice on this anniversary is to read stories about heroes from that day, of their loved ones left behind, and what was said in their last conversations. Inevitably, there will be tears.

One such story I read a few years ago was a book called *The Man I Never Met* by Adam Schefter. It is a moving account of the life and memory of Joe Maio, who died in the World Trade Center, leaving behind his wife, Sharri, and a 15 month old son. Five years later, Adam married Sharri and adopted Joe's son.

It is good to learn these stories and share in their grief. I pray we never forget. Such stories lead me to say, "Come, Lord Jesus. The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen." - Rev. 22:20b-21
