Consider how many Biblical prophecies were originally misunderstood. We only understand them because they have been fulfilled. If those ancient scholars were wrong then, we should allow that we could be wrong now.

We have a choice of where to place our confidence: we can stand on our views or on God. I am not smart enough to be right about everything, so I will allow that I may be wrong, but I know God isn't.
