Pastor's Pondering

Written in 1806, the poem Character of the Happy Warrior by William Wordsworth has some lines that seem to say one thing, but originally said something else.

For instance, the happy warrior is described as "the generous spirit." Reading that, I wondered why sharing more than is normal (generous) was important in a warrior. Looking into the meaning of generous, I discovered it is from the Latin genus: stock or race. In 1806, it meant someone of noble birth. The poem is saying he is a noble spirit. Granted, I hope a noble person will also share abundantly.

We have to be careful when we read older works with our modern understanding. Since the meaning of words changes over the years, we might miss the author's intent. Plenty of bad theology is based on nothing more than modern sensibilities interpreting ancient words and ideas.
