This position reports to the Coalition Leader and Campus Coordinator and carries out duties to implement strategies focusing on alcohol and drug availability, alcohol policy enforcement, and drinking norms – In order to achieve decreases in related problems, findings suggest coalitions need to take a comprehensive approach by implementing a variety of strategies.

Engage campus focus groups
Educate peers on Substance use
Communicate to peers using social media
Gather campus and neighborhood concerns
Document immediate concerns during outreach and document
