Bishop Strong has a powerful prayer team for the UFCCM 24 Hour Prayer Meeting. They are faithful and always willing to answer the call to pray.



Hold On To God's Unchanging Hand

Hello to our UFCCM family, I bring you greetings from the Caribbean Jurisdiction along with my wife Elder Karen Nixon. We pray that you would continue to Hold on to God's Unchanging hand as we move forward into a brighter future.

"Rather, cling tightly to the Lord your God as you have done until now." - (Joshua 23:8 NLT)

As we are facing life difficulties, we are all tempted to worry, wonder, and fret. What can be done? Where is God in the midst of this. We may ask the question; Will these hard times we are going through ever end?

If you've asked yourself this question lately, you're not alone. For many of us, life has not been easy in recent months, or even years. 



We have observed that many of the Deaconate desire UFCCM ID Credentials. They are now available for the same fee as the Ministerial Credentials.


