"And Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they fell upon their faces: and the glory of the Lord appeared unto them." Numbers 20:6

#### PRAY UNTIL YOU HEAR FROM THE LORD

Too many people expect a million-dollar answer from a ten cents prayer. The truth is that you must spend time before God in prayer on a regular basis. Keep time out in every day that you spend with God in prayer. Prayer draws you closer to God and keeps the devil powerless against you. He will attack on every opportunity and in any manner, but prayer is your barrier. Even so, there arise times when you must go beyond your regular prayer time to hear from the Lord. This is especially true for those whom the Holy Spirit has given a position of leadership or covering over his children.

The Children of Israel had journeyed to the Desert of Tzin also called Zin. Those who arrived at this point were predominately a new generation of wilderness wanderers who were born and raised in the wilderness. They complained to Moses about the desert and the lack of various foods and conveniences that they had probably heard their parents and elders talk about. They accused God's anointed leaders of "poor leadership" resulting in their ending up in an "evil place" where there were no figs, vines, seed, pomegranates, or water. Followers are usually content when things are going well, but quick to forget the good when they are faced with lack and crisis situations.

Do not forget that there is a "race to run," and a "wilderness to experience" and rivers to cross before you get to the "Promised Land." Give thanks to the Lord for leaders that are on "the wall" standing in the gap, interceding for you, who know how to Pray Until They Hear From the Lord. Follow their example and learn to PRAY UNTIL YOU HEAR FROM THE Lord! God always has a way out for you, but you must seek God for His directions and answers for your life. Moses and Aaron, in spite of having to mourn the death of their sister Miriam, went to the Lord, prostrated themselves before Him and stayed there until they heard from the Lord. What was an insurmountable crisis to Israel became a demonstration of God's mercy because of the prayers of Moses and Aaron. Both Moses and Aaron suffered denial of entrance into the promised land because, even though they were God's chosen, anointed and appointed leaders, the pressures of leadership caused Moses to react "in the flesh" to the aggravations resulting from leading God's children. We need to keep our leaders in our prayers. Everyone in front and "up there" is not a real leader. Real Leaders know how to and will Pray Until They Hear From the Lord. Consistently, by their example they teach God's children to PRAY UNTIL YOU HEAR FROM THE Lord!

Yet as leaders, Abba Father equips each with the powerful ability to boldly come before Him in prayer. *"Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need."* (Hebrews 4:16 KJV) Jesus considers each believer to be his friend if the believer does whatsoever Jesus commands. Please read this passage of Scripture from John 15:13-16 KJV

13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. 14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. 15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you. 16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.

Think about this: We did not choose Jesus, but HE CHOSE US TO BE HIS FRIENDS and as HIS friends we are granted the privilege to come BOLDLY before HIS presence in PRAYER! A true friend is not afraid to speak in confidence to a friend. 
Some childhood tears become adult despairs and trauma. Be careful of what you plant in your child's life. It is my prayer that this will encourage and heal someone.

General Overseer Pastor Henry A. Tindal, Jr Greetings, it is again that you find me Saved, Holy Ghost filled and in the daily process of Sanctification. Yes, I said daily. It is imperative that we as believers realize that when we are saved, that we need the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us with the process of Sanctification. (*I Thessalonians 5:23, "And the very God of peace shall sanctify you wholly; and I pray your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless until the coming of our Lord,"*). We are Sanctified when we ask God to set us apart, but the Word clearly teaches us that there is a process of Sanctification. The daily process is often referred to as "progressive Sanctification" and after we have received salvation, we often ask God to "set us apart" for His use and glory (*I Corinthians 6:11And such were some of you; but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and the spirit of our God."*).

As a child growing up in the church, I remember during revivals that the first night people would get saved, the second night they would come to the alter and repeat "sanctify me Lord, sanctify me Lord" with an earnest plea as if the person's life depended on it! Then Friday night would always be referred to as "Joy Night," and as a child, we knew that was the night that the Holy Ghost would cause people to shout and speak in a tongue that we couldn't understand.

The church mothers would be at the alter after my Dad or the guest revivalist would preach, and the people would come to the alter crying and waiting for "that feeling" to come over them. As a child I would secretly watch and often get excited when I would see someone "come through"! I would often secretly pray and ask God to allow that experience to happen to me.

As I grew older in the Lord and within the church and began to understand that speaking in tongues comes from God, I begin to see that a lot of people would speak under the influence of the Holy Ghost, but would also allow other words to come out of their mouth that may not be a good example as a Christian to the world. Hmmm.

We are not to judge, but this is why we have to ask God to fill us with His Holy Spirit because the Spirit will teach us how to live and talk and interact with others like Jesus did.

Thank God for the Holy Spirit who leads, guides, directs, corrects, rebukes, rejuvenates, encourages, and uplifts me daily! The Holy Ghost was promised to us by Jesus himself.

I thank God for the Holy Spirit and I live every day in a mind frame of sanctification. Daily, we should ask the Lord to sanctify us, ask the Saviour to take you through the process. Don't worry, if you slip, He is there to forgive you seventy times seven in a day (490 times) and if you need more forgiveness, His grace is sufficient.

We wanted to share our Thanks and Praise to our Father in Heaven for accepting these new Souls.







#### From The Desk of the Ecumenical Patriarch

**Some of** My Thoughts concerning the Believers response to being vaccinated for the COVID 19 Coronavirus.

This is a controversial subject that has become a point of division within the Church, The Body of Christ. Yet like any other matter about which a believer in Christ and a member of His body is called to make a decision, the believers response should come from the Word of the Lord. We must accept the Word of God as the final answer to any situation we encounter during our earth walk. We must remember and consistently be aware of the fact, that any issue which can be used to divide and cause confusion among the members of Christ's Body will be used with maximum strength by Satan in his quest to destroy the cohesiveness and love among God's people. The Apostle Paul clearly warns in 2 Corinthians 2:11, "...so that no advantage would be taken of us by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes." Highlight is mine. (New American Standard Bible) In addition consider the words of the Apostle Peter: "Be sober-minded and alert. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour." (1Peter 5:8 International Standard Version) In other words we must never, ever forget that our warfare is NOT against each other. It is NOT about flesh and Blood. According to the Word of God, our warfare is against unseen spiritual forces. "For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms." (Ephesians 6:12) New International Version

#### **YOUR DECISION**

Beloved considering the above statements and scriptures, it is our belief that the decision for or against being vaccinated for the COVID 19 Coronavirus based upon the Word of God should be based upon LOVE. We understand that there are political, medical, rights issues, and yes religious concerns that are involved in the believer's response to receiving the vaccination, but the main reason should be about Love. Would you deliberately harm a brother or sister? If what you do or do not cause a brother or sister to be offended, what should you do? Paul said, *"Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no*  *flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend."* (1Corinthians 8:13 KJV) This is not out of context. The matter was about meat during sacrament, but the principle is the same. As a believer we should never do anything that would cause our brother or sister to stumble. Even Jesus said, *"If anyone causes one of these little ones—those who believe in me—to stumble, it would be better for them to have a large millstone hung around their neck and to be drowned in the depths of the sea."* (Matthew 18:6 NIV)

#### THE PROBLEM

Unfortunately the issue under discussion puts all of us who are believers between a rock and a hard place. It is like one is dammed if he does or dammed if he does not! (dammed in the sense of judged) So if you receive the vaccination does this make you smarter or superior to the brother or sister who refuses to be vaccinated? If you refuse the vaccination does this indicate that you have some gnostic knowledge that places you in a place of higher intelligence over the vaccinated? The Bible says absolutely nothing about this modern-day injection called a vaccination. But it says a lot about our relationship that we as believers should have one with another.

#### **THE SOLUTION**

- 1. Remember that you are in the world but not of the world.
- 2. Do whatever you do in consideration of your brothers and sisters.
- 3. Do not seek to impose your will upon another.
- 4. Pray and seek the mind of Christ about your decision.
- 5. Remember that Your decision is just that, YOUR DECISION.
- 6. Remember the "Golden Rule."
- Remember that God has given man knowledge so that we can have better qualities of life here on this earth
- 8. Remember that vaccines are not a new phenomenon, most of us have taken them since we were infants
