

**Sandy Cove offers wonderful accommodations:** They offer an all-inclusive package, consisting of overnight lodging in deluxe hotel-style accommodations in their Chesapeake Lodge, all-you-can-eat meals, a wide variety of recreational activities, and meeting space.

The reduced small group winter package rates for a two night weekend stay with five meals (dinner on the day of arrival thru continental breakfast on the day of departure) are as follows:
