Happy New Year 2022! Greetings and Blessings to All! What a joy and a privilege it is to bring to you another edition of the **UFCCM National Newsletter**.

The Lord has been merciful and gracious and has allowed us to "crossover" into a new year. We have much to praise God for, because there are many who were here with us last year but are no longer amongst us. For some of us our hearts are yet grieving the loss of a loved one. We shudder at the thought that we can no longer hear their voices, see their lovely smiling faces, or just share a conversation that lifts our spirits. We long to be with our loved ones whom God has called from labor to rest. We are encouraged because we know that we will meet them once again in glory.

Recently, we have been studying the book of Job and some of the sufferings that he and his family experienced. Job was not in this by himself- not much is said about Mrs. Job, but it is certain that she suffered as well. She received the report that all of her children were dead, they lost EVERYTHING that they had managed to accumulate in this world (their earthly possessions). All that they had left were the clothes on their backs (so to speak). What a devastating loss! She cried out in pure anguish, Job 2:9 "Dost thine still retain thine integrity? Curse God, and die" (KJV), the Amplified Bible states: "Then his wife said to him, Do you still cling to your integrity [and your faith and trust in God, without blaming Him]? Curse God and

But in the next verse Job gave a rebuttal, Job 2:10, "But he said to her, 'You speak as one of the [spiritually] foolish women speaks [ignorant and oblivious to God's will]. Shall we indeed accept [only] good from God and not [also] accept adversity and disaster?' In [spite of] all this Job did not sin with [words from] his lips."

Look at our world and its situation. There are believers who have even lost their livelihoods for their trust and faith in God. There are some believers who have even lost their lives for their belief or trust in Christ.

Sometimes Christians are led to believe that trusting God guarantees them a life free of problems, free of troubles, free of sickness, and free of poverty. Many are preaching and teaching prosperity for our physical man and not preaching and teaching spiritual prosperity for our spirit man. Rather, they are focusing on gaining material things here on earth to make our lives comfortable. But remember we are sojourners, and we did not come here to stay- this is not our permanent home.

Job recognized this when he asked the question in Job 14:14 "When a man dies, will he live again? All the days of my hard service I will wait, until my renewal comes." (AB) Some things happen to test our faith. Remember that the trying of our faith is much more precious than gold that perishes. (1 Peter 1:6-7). Psalms 37:1 (KJV) tells us "Do not fret because of evildoers, nor be envious of the workers of iniquity for they shall soon be cut down like the grass." The Psalmist goes on to encourage us to commit your way to the Lord, "Trust also in Him and He shall bring it to pass" (or bring it to fruition or to the expected end) Psalms 37:5. Remember Job was not privy to the conversation that Satan had with God just prior to the temptation and testing that he brought upon this righteous man Job. Job was not aware, but he chose to absolutely trust God no matter what!

In the midst of loss and temptation we must choose to trust God. Beloved this is what we must do in order to survive, in order to move forward in faith we are to remain "....steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the Work of the Lord" (1 Corinthians 15:58)

ECUMENICAL PATRIARCH'S ANNUAL MESSAGE FOR 2022



To all of the saints scattered throughout the United States, The Caribbean and abroad,

Grace, mercy, and peace to you from God our Father and our Lord and savior, Christ Jesus. We all began a journey with our Savior at the moment that we received this great salvation in which we consistently rejoice. Our journey, which is ordered by the Lord has brought us together in the United Fellowship of Christian Churches and Ministries, (UFCCM) which this year enters its eighteenth year of growth.

Looking back over the record we are reminded of the milestones that we have marked, and the wonderful and blessed experiences we have shared as we have traveled together. Looking ahead and anticipating continued growth and blessings of greater anointing and timely impartations from the Lord, **we have been led of the Lord to declare as our theme for this year, STEADFAST, UNMOVEABLE, ALWAYS ABOUNDING IN CHRIST**. THIS THEME IS TAKEN FROM THE Apostle Paul's words of encouragement and admonition to the Corinthian believers as he concluded his great treatise on the resurrection. This passage is in 1 Corinthians 15:58. ***"Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord."***

During the first radio broadcast of the Laity Training Ministry's UFCCM Anointed Radio Ministry, we were blessed of the Lord to announce this theme during the delivery of our Annual Message. Below we have prepared a condensed version of this message. We pray that it will bless, and encourage you on your continued walk of faith.

Excerpts from Ecumenical Patriarch's ANNUAL MESSAGE

God told Joshua to **Be Strong**, to **Be VERY Courageous**, Be Faithful to the WORD of GOD, and know that **I will be with you wherever you go!**

In like manner, we find ourselves having come this far, **walking by faith, and not by sight**, through the uncharted wilderness of 2021. **Continuing to move forward by faith**, we must now continue to go forward and face new achievements, new experiences, new obstacles, new and demanding situations, new challenges, and uncertainties. Like Joshua we need a **WORD FROM THE LORD**. We do not know what we may have to face in this new year, but there is one thing of which we are absolutely sure. We are assured that we do not walk alone, and that the same faith we have in our unchangeable God that has brought us this far will continue to be with us and carry us.

Remember this theme for 2022. Be **STEADFAST**, Be **UNMOVEABLE**, Be **ALWAYS ABOUNDING IN CHRIST!**

Be steadfast: from the Greek the connotation is that of being perseverant. It means to be firm in the faith. To remain established. To not be turned aside from what you believe. An allusion is made to a wrestling match in the sense of a winner **STANDS HIS GROUND!** The Spirit is saying, no matter what you hear, what you see others doing, regardless of where you see others going, **YOU STAND YOUR GROUND!** Remember what Paul told the saints in Galatia. He said Galatians 5:1 ***“Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.***

In the Greek, the word **unmoveable** means do not yield to temptation by others to move you from that in which you stand. I like the analogy from the song I SHALL NOT, I SHALL NOT BE MOVED, LIKE A TREE PLANTED BY THE WATERS, I SHALL NOT BE MOVED. Psalms 1:1 says, the unmoveable, ***“shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth its fruit in his season; his leaf shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.”*** To be unmoveable your roots must run deep. A tree planted by rivers of water, has a **tap root**. That tap root is always seeking a source of water. The unmoveable believer has a tap root! His tap root is connected to the fountain that never runs dry. Ephesians 3:17, tells us that because Christ dwells in our hearts by faith, we are rooted and grounded in love.

The phrase **ALWAYS ABOUNDING IN CHRIST** means to be exceedingly active and energetic, in doing the work of the Lord. It implies be fully engaged in obedience to the word, the way, and the will of Christ. Give no space to the devil. But render full obedience to the work of the Lord.

We understand that the battles of 2022 are not ours but God's. What we must face in 2022 is uncertain, but through it all the Lord Says tell his people to be **STEADFAST, UNMOVEABLE, ALWAYS ABOUNDING IN CHRIST!**

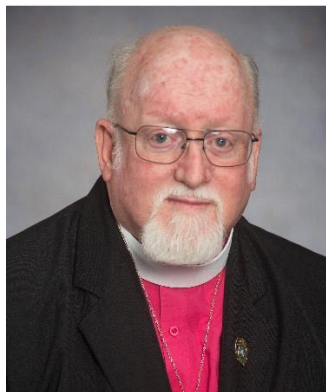

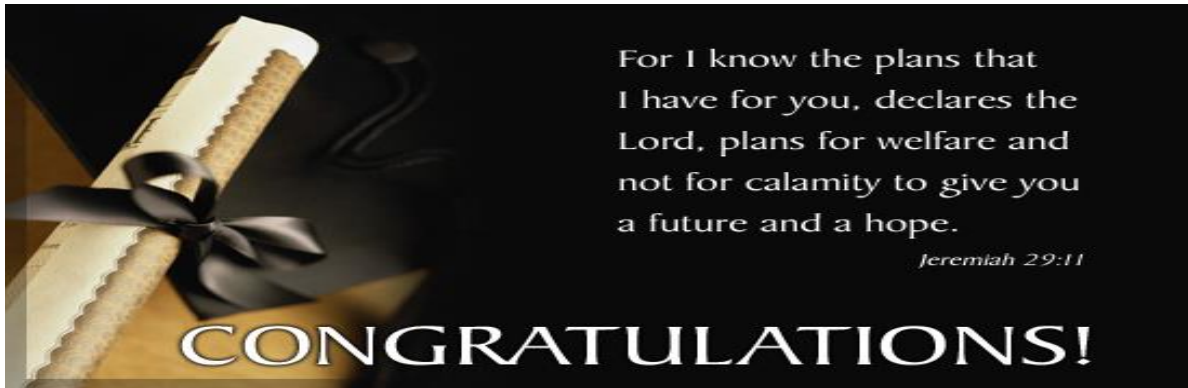

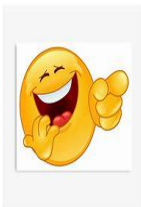
