**Who:** MEN and boys ONLY-boys age 8-15

**Dates:** July 28-31, 2022

**Cost:** \$650 per pair (1 father and 1 son)

- 3 evenings of hog hunting on Private Land with feeders
- Manhood Discussions
- 4 hour canoe trip on the Pea River
- Gun safety/ Skeet Shooting
- Bring Rifle and Shotgun

## Welcome to Ironman Outdoors

This part of South Central Alabama has a high concentration of hogs!

Bring your rifle! Father and Sons can both hunt (from the same shooting house).

We will also be able to hunt hogs at night! Bring thermal, Night vision, or a good light.





For this retreat, Ironman Outdoors has the exclusive hunting rights to over 1500 acres. This land includes 15 food plots and 12 feeders.... providing great habitat to hogs.







- Your retreat will be guided by a ProStaff member of Ironman Outdoors.
- This means each guest will be taken to their stands prior to each hunt and each guest will be picked up at their stand at the end of each hunt.
- Stands will most likely be 2 man shooting houses.
- Each stand will be baited with corn (legal now in AL).







**NEVER** leave your stand at any time during a hunt.  
There will be no stalking and no tracking of any animals without a guide present.





**We will also spend a day canoeing down the Pea River near Elba, AL. The cost of the canoe trip is included in the retreat fee.**





**We will also spend a morning doing Gun Safety and Skeet Shooting! Each father and son must bring their own shotgun and shells. IO will provide the clays and thrower.**







- For lodging, we have a farm house located on the hunting property.
- Each man will have his own bed.
- Linens are not provided.
- Please bring twin-sized sheets and/or sleeping bag.





Meals and snacks will be provided....  
including snacks that you can take with you  
to the treestand.



Please DO NOT leave trash  
on (or in) the stands.



## HUNTING LICENSE

- Prior to allowing anyone to hunt, each attendee will be required to:
  - Sign a liability waiver
  - Show a Valid Hunting License for the state of AL.
- **Dads** - An Alabama hunting license is available for purchase on-line (non-resident 3 Day = \$47.05 and is valid for 72 hours from purchase).
- You will also need a Baiting Permit (\$51.85)
- You will also need a Night Hunting Permit (\$51)
- **Sons** – if under age 16, no license needed, only a free H.E.L.P permit available from AL DNR
- **Note** - If you violate a game law, we will call the game warden and you will be asked to leave the retreat without refund.





## HARVEST DETAILS

- During the retreat, each hunter will be allowed to harvest unlimited hogs.





## HARVEST DETAILS

- We will have a place to skin and clean your harvest but we suggest that you bring a cooler to transport any meat harvested.
- No cleaning fees or tips are expected but help with cleaning your harvest is welcomed.





## MANHOOD DISCUSSIONS

- During our four days together, we will gather as a group to conduct our “Manhood Discussions”
- These discussions are simply an authentic and transparent conversation about what it means to be a Christian man.
- Topics may range from hunting, work, fatherhood and women to leadership, sports and everyday life.
- These are Not Bible Studies, They’re Not Devotions and They’re Not Sermons.
- Every man on the retreat is respectfully expected to be present for these discussions.

### MANDATORY

- Valid AL Hunting License
- Rifle and Hunter Orange Vest
- Flashlight
- Towel & Scent-Free Soap
- Sleeping bag, Pillow and Blanket
- Hunting gear needed to keep you comfortable in the stand.
- No Personal Treestands Allowed
- No Alcohol allowed

### SUGGESTED

- Rain Gear & Rubber Boots
- Cooler
- Bug Spray and/or Thermacell
- Rangefinder & Binoculars
- Cooler to take home "harvest"
- "Camp Chair"
- Cushion to sit on – while Hunting
- If you have only 1 favorite kind of soft drink....bring it with you.

## Our Policy:

### REFUNDS

- We can allow refunds if given 30 days notice before the retreat. We will subtract 3% if fees were paid with a card.
- No refunds within 30 days of the retreat.
- A deposit (usually 50% of hunt cost) is required upon booking a retreat. No retreat will be considered booked until Ironman Outdoors receives a deposit.



## Our Policy:

### **BALANCE DUE**

- Any outstanding or remaining reservation balance is due at least 14 days prior to the retreat.
- All retreats must be paid in full before any hunting takes place.
