REVEREND DR. HENRY L. FULLER JR.

Rev. Dr. Henry L. Fuller, Jr., was born in Hernando, Mississippi, he grew up in Arkansas, where he attended Lincoln Elementary and High School.

After moving to Flint, Michigan, he received and a Degree from Mott Community College and Bachelor of Theology Degree from United Bible Institute of United Theological Seminary – Flint Branch. Honorary Doctorate from United Bible Institute of United Theological Seminary of Monroe, Louisiana.



He is married to Marilyn W. Fuller, father of four: Jacqueline, Kathy, Henry L. III, and Jennifer; grandfather of seven.

After accepting the call into the Gospel ministry, he preached his first message December 12, 1971 at the Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, Flint, Michigan. Later, February 3, 1973, he organized a Mission in Holly, Michigan and on July 14, 1973 the Mission became known as Faith Baptist Church. Pastor Fuller was later called to Muncie, Indiana as Pastor/Shepherd of the Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, and served there from November 1983 to June 7, 1998.

His State and National work includes: while in Muncie, Indiana, serving as President of the Northeastern District Sunday School and BTU Congress of Christian Education of the Northeastern District Missionary Baptist Association; President of Indiana Consolidated State Congress of Christian Education of the Indiana Consolidated State Convention; Instructor of the National Baptist Congress of Christian Workers of the National Baptist Convention of America, Inc., serving on the Publishing Board as writer for Sunday School and BTU literature of the National Baptist Convention of America, Inc., and on the Finance Board of the National Baptist Convention of America, Inc.; Instructor at the Central Baptist Theological Seminary of Indiana; currently serving as a member of the Board of Trustees of the American Baptist College, Nashville, Tennessee, Director and Instructor at United Bible Institute of Flint, Michigan.

On April 18, 1998 he was called back to Flint, Michigan to his home church to assume the pastorate of the Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church. He served as Moderator of the Great Lakes Baptist District Association, Flint, Michigan (2000-2007) and was elected President of the Wolverine State Missionary Baptist Convention, August 2, 2007, in the 88th Annual Session. In the 94th Annual Session of the Wolverine State Missionary Baptist Convention, Inc., he was elected President for a second term.

The Foreign Mission Board of the National Baptist Convention, U.S.A., Inc., presented him with the Nelson Mandela Leadership Award September 9, 2015 at the 135th Annual Session, in Memphis, Tennessee.
