So That You May Know An Expositional Study of the Epistle of **1 John 5:14-17** Chapter 28- The Confidence That We Have in Him 259 Asking According to God's Will- Part 3

Welcome again, my beloved in Jesus Christ. We're continuing our verse by verse "journey" through the Epistle of **1John**, and today we are going to continue our new section of our study and look again at what John taught about "The Confidence we have in Jesus Christ"- so let's open our Bibles and read **1John 5:14-17** again together:

14 This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

15 And if we know that He hears us *in* whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.

¹⁶ If anyone sees his brother committing a sin not *leading* to death, he shall ask and *God* will for him give life to those who commit sin not *leading* to death. There is a sin *leading* to death; I do not say that he should make request for this.

17 All unrighteousness is sin, and there is a sin not *leading* to death.

Now on the last broadcast- we were examining verse 14 closely and I want to go into that verse again today- so let's read verse 14 again together:

This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

Now John is teaching here that we should have great confidence that anytime we ask God something that is in accordance with His Will-He will always hear us. So, since that is true- then our ability to know God's Will is paramount- if we are to be able to pray in accordance with God's Will.

Now there is much teaching about how we can know God's Will and there are many books out there that claim to teach people how they can know God's Will. We live in a day when self-appointed "prophets"who are accountable to no one- roam all across our nation claiming to be able to lay hands on you and to give you "a word" that will guide you into doing God's Will. They say that God speaks special revelation to them and that they alone have a hot line to Heaven that allows them to see and hear things that the average person does not see or hear.

There are books and tapes available for you to purchase that supposedly teach you how to give what they call, "personal prophecies" to someone else. And there are classes about how to interpret dreams and visions. All of this is designed to help people know what God's Will for their lives are and so they can do great and mighty things for God.

Dear friends, please hear me on this. I know that many people are very sincere and earnest about a lot of these things- but it is absolutely amazing the length that people will go to; the money that they are willing to spend; the distance they are willing to travel so they can know God's Will- while so few are willing to do what God said to do so that they will absolutely know God's Will.

Knowing what God's Will is- is not some mystical experience; it isn't something that is ethereal or vague or hard or strange. You don't have to go into a trance to know God's Will; you don't have to rise into a place of emotional ecstasy to realize what God's Will is and you don't need thousands of dollars' worth of tapes or books or travel to Tibet or have some prima donna prophet lay hands on you.

We have the final, full, complete revealed Will of God in our hands and yet today so few actually read it and even less than that actually study it. It is called the Holy Bible and the result of us not reading the most important Book on earth and the result of us not studying the only God breathed document that exists on earth- is that we are ignorant of what it says and therefore we honestly don't know God's Will.

And that great vacuum created by God's Own people not knowing God's Will has brought about the proliferation of all these mystical cults and false prophets and false teachers and a revival of ancient heresies and a promotion of idolatry and materialism and covetousness and a love for money and inconsistent and contradictory man-made doctrines and wrong Theology and militant atheists and unbiblical practices and spiritual abuse by ungodly leaders and sexual and financial scandals in our day like the world has never seen. All because the people of God no longer know God's Word and therefore they no longer know God's Will. And while all the bad news that I just spoke about is true and while it is also true that it is getting worse by the day- it is also true that as God's redeemed sons and daughters- we can fix this problem of not knowing God's Will. The solution lies at our feet and if we will simply apply this solution. All those bad and terrible things that came about as a direct result of God's people *not* knowing God's Will- will go back into the pit from whence they came.

And the solution is- that as God's people- we need to engage ourselves in serious, deep, ongoing, systematic, planned and scheduled line by line, verse by verse, precept by precept study of all 66 Books of the Holy Bible. And over time- most of our questions will be answered; and most of our confusion will be abated; and most of our doubts will fade away and we will be strong in the Lord and in the power of His Might.

Now I can hear all the objections to what I just said. *"I don't have the time to study the Bible"* is probably the one I hear the most. And I'm not trying to get anybody to do anything they don't want to- but really and truly dear friends- that excuse is really lame.

First of all- people do what they enjoy doing. Sporting events and recreation and entertainment and all of those things are at an all-time high in this country. More people talk about "discretionary income" and "discretionary time" than ever before. Discretionary money is what is left over after you pay all your bills. Discretionary time is what is left over after you work at your job. More people have more discretionary money and discretionary time now than at any other point in human history. So the real reason that people don't study the Bible is that they don't want to or they don't enjoy it- not because they don't have the time.

But like I said, people usually do what they want to do- what they enjoy doing and therein lies the real tragedy about all of this because if God's people don't enjoy studying what their Lord has said- who willthe lost world?

Now that is my argument against using the excuse about not having the time to study God's Word. I don't buy it for one second. What is really the case is that we do a very poor job or setting priorities about things that are important versus things that excite our flesh. It is just easier for us to watch a game on TV than to try to wade through all the funny names that Moses wrote in the Old Testament. It is easier for us to watch a movie that has a moral aspect to it than it is to go back to ancient Greek or Hebrew to find the meaning of a word. But dear friends, that is precisely the problem.

If all we do in life is what we want to; or that which will tickle our ears or that which will make us laugh- or that which will entertain usif all we do is what is easy- then we wouldn't even work on our jobs; and we wouldn't do the difficult things to keep our marriage strong; we wouldn't make those sacrifices that are needed to raise our children rightly; and we wouldn't defend our nation from attack; or do anything that required effort.

So the real underlying reason why we are looking at a radical decrease of time spent in God's Word among God's people; the real reason why so few people today know the Bible; the cause of so many saved people not understanding the God Who saved them is that we no longer value the Bible. We do not place as high a priority on Bible Study that we place on other things that are at best temporary and that can never help us to understand God's Will or give us strength when the storms of life come.

And this famine was prophesied about 700 years before Jesus was born. Look at what the prophet Amos said about this in **Amos 8:11&12:**

¹¹ "Behold, days are coming," declares the Lord God, "When I will send a famine on the land, Not a famine for bread or a thirst for water, But rather for hearing the words of the Lord.

12 "People will stagger from sea to sea And from the north even to the east; They will go to and fro to seek the word of the Lord, But they will not find *it*.

Now notice that Amos didn't say that we would have a famine of the Word of the Lord- but that we would have a famine of *hearing* the Words of the Lord. You see, Amos didn't say there would be a famine for a lack of Churches or a lack of Bibles or a lack of preachers or a lack of Christian Book Stores or Christian radio and television stations or Christian music or movies or concerts or any lack of anything like that.

No, Amos prophesied very specifically that this famine was not like any other famine that had ever come upon Man. Amos said this famine was in the ear of Man and this famine caused people to not be able to hear the only thing that they need to hear- the words of the Lord. And we are living in that day, dear friends when God's people actually hearing and seeing and knowing and understanding and loving and living and obeying and defending God's Word is at an all-time low.

And this famine- like all famines- is God's Righteous Judgment against a wayward people who love pleasures more than they love God; who love themselves more than they love God; who love money more than they love God; who love to do what is right in their own eyes and who love to serve God according to their own terms.

And God is not pleased that we have chosen our ways above His Ways; and God is not pleased that we have walked in our own ways and sought counsel from the ungodly and have put more value on our blessings than we do on the One Who blesses.

And so God has sent us a famine- and our ears have been affected by this famine. And this famine is very great and this famine is very dry and it has come up upon our land to plague us so that we will awaken out of our slumber and so that we will once again value the Words of the Lord.

"Well, what is the answer to this famine, Brother Blair?" The same answer that is always the answer whenever God plagues His Own people. Repentance. **2Chronicles 7:14** says:

and My people who are called by My name humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

The Acts 3:19 says:

Therefore repent and return, so that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord;

And so we need to repent and we need to beg God to give us a revival of love for Him and a revival of love for His Word and then we can regroup and reprioritize our lives so that we don't spend time with God and His Word *if* we find the time- but rather that we so value God and we so value what God has said that we will aggressively push other things out of the way and we *make time* to spend with God and we *make time* to pray and we *make time* to read and study God's Word so that we know what God's Will is and so we will once again know how to pray and so we will once again know what God loves and what God hates and so that we can earnestly contend for the faith that was once and for all delivered to the saints.

Now I really don't know a lot about this other than to say that the best time according to the Bible to study God's Word and pray is early in the morning. Now that doesn't mean that you can't study and pray at different times during the day- in fact you should pray without ceasing and you should study all during the day.

But every major character in the Bible- including Jesus rose up early in the morning- way before light and they spent time with God in prayer and in the study of His Word. Now I didn't put that in the Bible dear friends- but check it out yourself.

And while this is certainly not a requirement- it is a pattern that not only Biblical characters did- but which carried over into History as well. And so George Washington, John Adams, Samuel Chadwick, the Puritans, Augustine, Jonathan Edwards, Charles Spurgeon all rose up early and sought God and studied the Bible for hours before they ever started their day as well.

It was a requirement at one time at Harvard University that students had to have two hours of Bible Study and payer before class began- and classes started at 7am- and that was the Business School.

So I encourage you to examine your daily schedule and to push aside things that are frivolous and that don't matter to make room for Prayer and the study of the Word of the Lord so that we will once again know God's Will.
