4)	Abraham knew that whatever God had planned, it would end	
	up with Isaac and	
5)	The man who had at God's promise learned	
	that God always keeps his word.	
6)	God rewardedfor his faith, just as he rewards	
	us for our faith today.	
7)	The story of Abraham and Isaac is a of the	
	sacrifice of God's dearly loved, only begotten son – Jesus.	
8)	The sacrifice of the ram on Mt. Moriah was a substitute for the	
	death of Isaac. In the same way, the	
	death of Christ on Mt. Calvary gives us eternal life when we	
	accept it by faith, trusting God, just as Abraham did.
