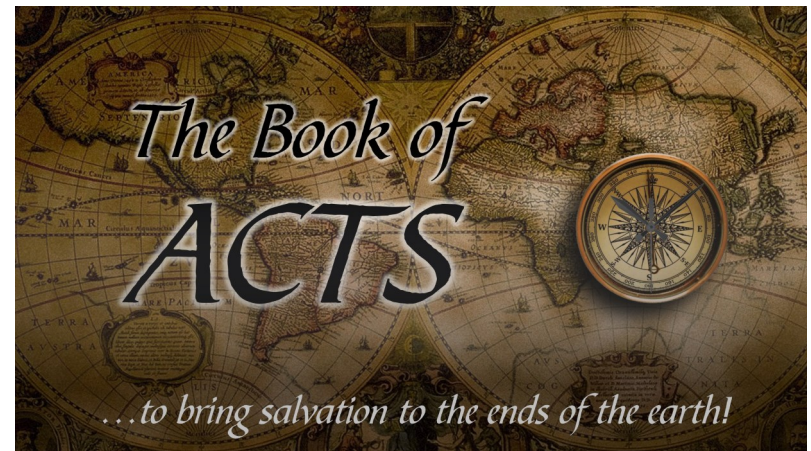


Can you identify instances in your own life where you chose to surrender your plans or desires in order to follow God's will? How did things turn out?

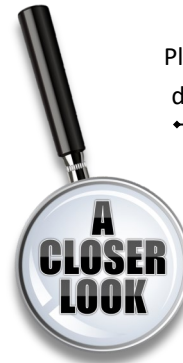
