Dear Parents and/or Guardians:

When you had your child baptized you agreed to train your child in the practice of our faith. This included catechizing him/her in the Catholic Church and her teachings. The goal of our volunteers and staff members to assist you in this catechesis.

We have several options available for your family to participate in the faith formation program of Saint Andrew Parish:

Sunday morning:	Pre-K 3 through 5 <sup>th</sup> grade:	9:00 to 10:15 a.m.
	6 <sup>th</sup> through 8 <sup>th</sup> grade:	8:45 to 10:15 a.m.
Wednesday evening:	Kindergarten through 5 <sup>th</sup> grade:	6:30 to 7:45 p.m.
	6 <sup>th</sup> grade through 8 <sup>th</sup> grade:	6:30 to 8:00 p.m.

If for some reason neither Sunday nor Wednesday will work for you family we do have a home study option. With this option you will be given the tools and teach your child at home. Monthly updates via chapter and unit reviews completed by the child will be required to be submitted. **A change in this program is that these will be required to be turned in no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month beginning November 1<sup>st</sup>.** In addition I will be having a required parent meeting on September 12<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. if you choose this option. **If you are not able to attend this meeting you may not be able to participate in this program.**

Once you have determined which option works best for your family complete the registration form and return it with the registration fee to the Pastoral Center or mail it to the address below. Be sure to take advantage of early registration with the reduced fee! If you need to discuss payment of the fees please contact either myself or my assistant, Star Fedor, in the Pastoral Center. Aides or assistants receive a 50% reduction of fees if you faithfully come to assist us on Sunday or Wednesday. (*Faithfully coming means attending all class sessions unless we are notified prior to class date as well as attending catechist meetings.*)

**Please note:** If someone other than the parent or guardian is to bring or pick up your child you must notify us in writing before the event. The person will need to bring a picture ID when picking up your child. Children will not be accepted from or released to siblings younger than high school.

We look forward to continuing the faith journey with your family and furthering the spread of the Gospel and the Church's teachings. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
