Their Story

"Their Story" is a segment of our newsletter that focuses on how individuals have lived unique lives in the service of the King.

"I'm falling," thought fireman Bob Bailey as he tumbled through the roof and into the attic of a house that was engulfed in flames. He was not hurt, just embarrassed, as his partners laughed lightheartedly.



Bob was raised in Central Point in a Christian family with five siblings. He went to church until age 12, after which busy activities took over in his life. But he always knew that God existed. After high school and one year of college, Bob enlisted for three years in the Army where he trained to be a combat engineer. He was in Vietnam for two years and then came home to the Oregon National Guard for a year. Bob liked Army life and its structured ways. While on leave from Vietnam Bob met a young woman named Gail. It was love at first sight. Unfortunately, he had to leave immediately to go back. Through many letters back and forth, Bob and Gail came to know each other, and they married a year later. After the military, Bob went to work for the Central Point Rural Fire Department and stayed with them for 29 years. He retired in 2000.

Gail lived in Coquille until age six when the family moved to Central Point. She went to church with her mother when she was small, and went forward to meet Jesus when she was four. But it was her grandmother, who lived next door, who nurtured her in the faith. Gail attended CBC until she was a teenager. She and Bob never walked away from the Lord, but they "were not always obedient." After high school and marriage to Bob, Gail went to college for two years. Gail worked in management in many jobs and retired in 2009.

In 2012 Gail suggested that they go to CBC, and it was then that Bob made a deep commitment to the Lord; and now he understands the role the Lord played in his life. Not long afterwards, Gail was diagnosed with lung cancer. About God's purpose for the cancer, she says, "I am like a puzzle piece. I don't know what my role is but God will put the piece in place one day. Whatever the outcome, I am ready for it. I am not going to let it stop me from enjoying life."

And they do enjoy life. They like hiking camping, gardening, reading, cooking, hunting and fishing, though Gail's health keeps her from doing some of those activities. She also enjoys scrapbooking.
